

ANTONIA B. NUNCIO

1926 - 1998

Antonia B. Nuncio, 69 of Castroville, TX and Bay Port died Sunday morning at St. Mary's Medical Center, Seguin following a four month illness.

She was born Sept. 29, 1928 in Texas to the late Martin and Maria (Bunato) Martinez. On Jan. 10, 1941 she was united in marriage to Domingo D. Nuncio in Texas. He preceded her in death in January of 1978.

Mrs. Nuncio had come to Bay Port in April to visit her family. Shortly after her arrival she became ill and was hospitalized most of her stay. She was a member of St. Louis Catholic Church in Castroville, TX.

A funeral mass will be conducted at St. Louis Catholic Church, Castroville, TX on Thursday with burial in the church cemetery.
