New Bible Study to Begin

Janeen WIII DE TACIIITATING A NEW BIDIE STUDY, "REJECTED Prophets – Jesus and His Witnesses in Luke - Acts," by Jocelyn McWhirter. From the book cover: *The Agenda Behind Luke's Story - By the 80s of the first century, the Romans had killed Jesus, Peter, and Paul; ravaged Jerusalem; and destroyed the temple. Many Gentiles believed in Jesus, while most Jews did not. In order to show that all this was part of God's plan, Luke compares Jesus and his witnesses to Israel's prophets who also went to the nations and were rejected by some of their own people.*

The study will begin Wednesday, May 8th, with an introductory session. There will be an afternoon study at 12:00 PM (bring your lunch!) and an evening study at 7:00 PM.
