Terry Mosher, a native of Richland, NY, graduated from Pulaski High School, Pulaski, NY in 1980, and enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in March 1981.

After graduating USAF Security Police Academy in 1981, he served as a Law Enforcement Specialist at numerous installations to include Lackland AFB, TX, Clark Air Base, Republic of the Philippines, Hill AFB, UT, and Royal Air Force (RAF) Greenham Common, UK.

In 1990, he crossed trained into the USAF Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) and attended the AFOSI Academy at Bolling AFB, DC. Special Agent (SA) Mosher was assigned to numerous AFOSI Detachments to include, Seymour Johnson AFB, NC, Andrews AFB, MD, Kunsan AB, ROK, Procurement Fraud Detachment, Arlington, TX. SA Mosher retired from Active Duty on 1 April 2001.

In October 2001, immediately following the 9-11 terrorist attack, SA Mosher was hired as a Civilian SA with AFOSI and returned to duty at the Procurement Fraud Detachment, Arlington, TX. He served as a Civilian SA until 2010 when he accepted a position as a SA with the DoD Office of Inspector General (Defense Criminal Investigative Service.)

As a Special Agent with DCIS, he served in numerous positions such as Program Manager, Program Director, and Assist Special Agent in Charge of the Central Field Office. He retired from Civil Service in 2021.

He is a former Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE) with the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners, and holds numerous college degrees to include an Associate's Degree from the Community College of the Air Force, a Bachelors of Science Degree from the University of Maryland, and a Masters of Arts Degree from Dallas Baptist University.
