MINUTES January 21, 2015

Chairman Chamberlain called the regular meeting of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority to order at 7:30 p.m. The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

CFO'S REPORT

Mr. Francisco was present to give the CFO report because Mr. Olshefski was attending the county budget hearing.

The renewal of the Financial Advisory Support Services shared services agreement with Warren County will be on the Freeholders agenda for next week's meeting. The fee will be the same for 2015, \$1,000 per month (\$12,000 annually), and it will be a five-year agreement.

The final financial reports for 2014 were distributed prior to the meeting. Because the Authority paid off a lot of debt, the cash balance was lower at the end of 2014 than 2013. The Authority came in under budget; and is in good financial shape going forward.

Mr. Kiszonak inquired about the budgeted Expenditure Summary figure of \$3.9 million on page two. This is because the 2014 budget was amended by approximately one million dollars to pay off the debt. Funds from the Rate Stabilization Surplus were used to retire bonds. A great deal of money was saved in interest by paying off the bonds early.

Mr. Francisco left the meeting.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At approximately 7:42 p.m., Mr. Scott moved to adopt Resolution #15-01 to enter into executive session to discuss a contract matter. Ms. O'Connor seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

At approximated 8:05 p.m., Mr. Rosenberg moved and Mr. Scott seconded to return to open session. All in favor, motion carried.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Chairman Chamberlain requested approval by the Board to send a letter drafted by Florio, Perrucci, Steinhardt & Fader, notifying Tomar Construction Services that if substantial completion and final completion schedules are not met according to Contract #12-01(Oxford WWTP Upgrade), action will be taken.

Mr. Piazza made a motion to approve sending the above-mentioned letter to Tomar, those listed to be copied, and the NJDEP. Mr. Rosenberg seconded. He reminded Ms. Fina to add the word "additional". All in favor, motion carried.

Ms. Fina had nothing else to report.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Donati's report was included in the agenda packets.

Oxford WWTF ACO: CPE prepared and submitted the quarterly report to the NJDEP.

Belvidere WWTF NJPDES Permit: CPE prepared and submitted the permit renewal application to the DEP. The discharge permit for each plant is a five-year permit.

DRBC: CPE prepared and submitted the annual effluent monitoring report. The report confirmed that all discharge limits were met during 2014.

Oxford WWTF Upgrade: Mr. Donati displayed photos of the progress so far and gave an update on the status of the schedule of the project. Mr. Wauhop interjected with comments on the equipment for the project.

Warren Haven Pump Stations Rehab (design phase): CPE is pursuing actual operating data because they are concerned about the design parameters used originally.

Chemical Supply Contract No. 15-01: Bids were opened on January 8. However, after review by the Authority's engineer and attorney, all three bids were found to have a non-waivable fatal defect and deemed non-responsive. Discussion ensued regarding the issue with the lowest bidder. There was a math error in their calculation. Ms. Fina expounded on case law related to math errors, and did not want the MUA opening itself up to a lawsuit from the other bidders. She and Mr. Donati advised the Authority to reject all three bids and rebid the contract.

Mr. Wauhop has already spoken to Main Pool, our current chemical supplier, and they have agreed to extend their current prices for another month.

Mr. Scott moved to reject all three bids and rebid the Chemical Supply Contract. Ms. Napolitani seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

AUTHORITY CONSULTANT

Mr. Wauhop distributed his report and a chart prior to the meeting. The chart shows the data submitted to the DRBC for the Oxford plant. The plant is running fine with the leachate, and the leachate has been consistent at about 25,000-28,000 gallons per day.

Belvidere STP: He recapped maintenance items performed during the month. We are waiting for the new Kaeser Blower to arrive.

Due to the cold weather, spray nozzles are freezing up. At night, if the sand filter is running, we run out of water to backwash the sand filter. This issue will be addressed later in the year when other changes are planned for this plant.

Oxford STP: He recapped maintenance items performed at the plant and various pump stations during the month.

General Business: We continue to get pricing for the plan to increase the sludge thickening at the Belvidere plant; also working on keeping the foam under control at the plant. The colder the weather, the worse the foam issue becomes.

Confined Space: Mr. Wauhop is still waiting for the Warren County Health Department to schedule the mask fitting tests. Several commissioners expressed dissatisfaction.

Mr. Wauhop continues his research for a part-time operator. Mr. Niece is still not convinced a permanent operator is needed; he would prefer a temporary part-time employee.

Mr. Wauhop has a conflict with scheduling our meetings on the third Wednesday of the month for February 2015 and August 2015. He suggested discussing it now since the schedule for the year is set at the Reorganization Meeting in February. The consensus of the Board was to reschedule the Reorganization meeting and regular meeting from February 18, 2015 to February 25, 2015. In addition, the August meeting will be on the fourth Wednesday, August 26, instead of the third Wednesday. Last year, we did not schedule the November meeting on the third Wednesday because of the League of Municipalities annual conference. Therefore, November's meeting will not be on the third Wednesday, but will be on the third Thursday, November 19.

Lastly, Mr. Wauhop has started the layout and design for the piping to connect the new Kaeser Blower.

Ms. Napolitani initiated discussion about the repair costs for the Ford Escort. She wondered if it was worth keeping. Mr. Wauhop stated the vehicle is used mostly by Mr. Wasser to travel between sites, since it gets better gas mileage than the trucks.

FINANCE

There were a couple of questions on the bills. Mr. Rosenberg questioned whether the amount we pay the county for gasoline is higher than we would pay commercially. He suggested the possibility of purchasing gas elsewhere. Mr. Rosenberg asked why we purchased two snow blowers. Mr. Wauhop said one was for each plant.

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #15-02 (Certificate No. 342: \$78,900.00) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund. Mr. Scott seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Mr. Piazza moved that Resolution #15-03 (Certificate No. 350: \$621,703.47) be approved to pay all the bills from the Capital Improvements Fund. Mr. Scott seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Chairman Chamberlain reminded everyone that our next meeting would be on the February 25.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public present.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Scott moved and Ms. O'Connor seconded that the meeting be adjourned. All in favor, motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:38 p.m.
