Must compete in a minimum of 2 shows to qualify for end of year award.

Ranch Pleasure AQHA SHW 416 No horse may cross enter a western pleasure and a ranch riding class at the same show. Regardless of division (youth, amateur, Select or Open).

Once a rider/horse team has competed in a lope/canter division they may not compete in W/T division, however, rider may compete in W/T division on a different horse. (See rules for end of year award)

Judges decision is final. Any unsportsmanlike conduct, profanity or public intoxication in the arena or show grounds will disqualify any contestant. NO PETS ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS per San Patricio County Fairground regulations.

AQHA rules unless otherwise stated. Definitions of individual classes available at show office. **No martingales, roping reins, or mechanical hackamores will be allowed.** Horses 5 and under may be shown in a snaffle or Bosal and ridden with two hands.

HI-HPOINT RULES: TEAM IS ONE HORSE - ONE RIDER. Must register for highpoint prior to first class entered at individual shows for daily Hi-point and Reserve awards. Age of rider as of January 1, of each year. Rider may compete for more than one Hi-point at daily shows where eligible. See rules for end of year Hi-point, must complete form.
