Debra Shelby, PhD, DNP, FNP-BC, DNC, FACDNP
NADNP/ACDNP President and Founder
Fellow of the American College of Dermatology Nurse Practitioners

Dr. Shelby has been practicing dermatology since she graduated as a Family Nurse Practitioner in January 2000. In 2006, she was accepted into the DNP doctoral program at the University of South Florida (USF). As her doctoral project, she developed the nation's first Doctorate of Nursing Practice (DNP) Dermatology Program and became the first resident ever to complete the program in 2008. She successfully defended her American Cancer Society grant award winning research titled: Knowledge, Attitudes and Practice of NPs Regarding Skin Cancer Assessments in February 2014. She has focused her academic and clinical experiences toward the treatment of skin cancers.

She is the President and Founder of the National Academy of Dermatology NPs and the American College of Dermatology NPs. Each year she serves as the Chair of Annual Conference Planning Committee for NADNP and ACDNP. This six-day conference offers basic and advanced dermatology tracks to NPs and PAs in all clinical settings. The conference profits go to Over 200 NPs and PAs scholarships and supports AAD Camp Discovery, Moffitt Cancer Center, National Psoriasis Foundation, Wounded Warriors Project, Metropolitan Ministries, and many other important charities. In 2015, Dr. Shelby became one of the first Fellow of the American College of Dermatology Nurse Practitioners (FACDNP) along with the other founding founders of NADNP in 2015.

Dr. Shelby is the CEO/Clinical Director of Florida Specialty Medical Services LLC Dermatology Division and Dermstaffing. Her company employs nurse practitioners to care for patients in extended living facilities and land based offices. She also is the CEO of the National Institute for Dermatology, LLC which offers comprehensive dermatology care, education, research and practice solutions.

Past clinical experience includes being a Perioperative Clinical Specialist at H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center where she was educated by the leaders in melanoma research and treatment and over 16 years of general and surgical dermatology practice in an office setting. Dr. Shelby also has over 13 years of legal consulting and expert witness experience which has led her to pursue a JD law degree starting in 2016.

Dr. Shelby served as the Affiliate Director of the DNP Dermatology Program at USF from 2007-2015. She is a guest speaker on dermatology related issues and is a dermatology clinical preceptor for doctoral and masters nurse practitioner students. Throughout her career she has presented nationally, developed nursing educational programs and conferences, published and continues her interest in research. She also serves on the editorial board for Advance for NPs and PAs.

In September of 2012, Dr. Shelby was asked by the Prime Ministry of Health in Singapore to visit dermatology nurses at the National Skin Centre to lecture on advanced practice and education in dermatology. She has made a priority goal of NADNP to connect with our international colleagues and serve as a resource and mentor.

He is a professor of surgery at the University of South Florida College of Medicine.

His research interests are in treating cutaneous melanoma, as well as, non-melanoma skin cancers and soft tissue sarcomas including, extremity, cutaneous and retroperitoneal sarcomas. He has a particular interest in minimally invasive regionally therapy such as isolated limb infusions (ILI) for extremity in transit or recurrent melanoma, ILIs for limb threatening unresectable sarcomas and percutaneous hepatic perfusions for unresectable metastatic melanoma to the liver. Dr. Zager has also developed an interest in intraoperative PET probe directed surgery for difficult to localize metastatic lesions.

Dr. Zager was selected by the NADNP/ACDNP Board of Director's to receive the NADNP's Distinguished Physician Award because of our experiences with his patient care, cutting edge research, and dedication to educating all health care providers. In the inception of NADNP and the DNP Dermatology Residency Program, he was the first to step forward to be a part of educating NPs.
