

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2011

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF
CHAPTER 6 OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES
PERTAINING TO THE VILLAGE'S MAILBOX REPLACEMENT POLICY**

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Section 6.18(a) is repealed and recreated to read as follows:
 - (a) The Village of Arlington will replace, pursuant to this Section, mailboxes damaged on the Village street system where it has been determined that:
 - (1) Physical damage, which can be proven and documented by the owner or by the Village, was caused by actual physical contact with Village equipment;
 - (2) The mailbox is of standard design and placed in conformance with United States Post Office standards; and
 - (3) The existing installation, mailbox and mailbox post were in good repair.
 - (4) Damage to the mailbox and/or mailbox post caused by the weight of plowed snow shall not qualify as physical damage for the purposes of this Section.
2. Section 6.18(b) is repealed.
3. Section 6.18(c) becomes 6.18(b).
4. Severability of Provisions. Should any section, sentence, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid, such portion shall be deemed as a separate and distinct provision and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
5. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and publication or posting as provided by law. Except as provided herein, all of the terms and provisions of Chapter 6 of the Village of Arlington Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.
