From the Minister's Mac:

The Connectional Church

One of the attributes about the United Methodist Church I love most is that we are "connectional." Being connectional in the UMC means that every United Methodist congregation is interconnected throughout the denomination via a unique, interlocking chain of conferences, which govern, and worship and do mission and ministry — together.

For me, being connectional is even more than that: It is about

human connection, and this is not exclusive to the United Methodist Church! Every Christian is interconnected with every other Christian in our denomination and with other denominations, through the love of Christ. We belong to one another as the Body of Christ. We not only care about each other, we need each other, and I believe this is how God intends us to live.

So, when the Body becomes fractured and people begin leaving, it hurts all of us, there's no getting away from that. At General Conference, it was said that roughly ¼ of United Methodist Churches have disaffiliated, most of them in the Southern Conferences. On one hand, I grieve over that figure. I pray for those churches. I pray for my church, and all the other churches and denominations who have gone through this kind of split. The Episcopalian Church in 2003, the Baptist Church in 2006, the Lutheran Church in 2009, and the Presbyterian Church in 2012: all split over the same issue that now divides United Methodists.

On the other hand, I recognize that this has happened before and will probably happen again. We have split over baptism, communion, race, gender, and now orientation. We humans have a knack for disagreement, and we Christian humans have not yet learned how to navigate those disagreements as well as we should.

So I pray. I pray that one day we learn to accept one another and remain united, in spite of our differences of opinion. I pray that we might be of one mind — the mind of Christ. I pray that as the body of Christ we stay as loving and giving toward one another as we have been in the past, even as we wrestle with issues that threaten to divide us.

I know you are praying with me, you mighty prayer warriors! And if we can keep loving one another and if we continue to keep our focus on Christ, I believe we can remain intact as a church. So, let's continue to love like Christ loves. Let's continue to care for one another. Let's continue to invest in our Christian relationships — not just at Rinn UMC, but also throughout our entire wrestling Church.

See you on Sunday, Lin "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love." 1 John 4:7-8
