### **ELECTRONICS TECHNICIAN**

New 2022 career opportunity for federal contractors in Panama City Beach, Florida. Candidate must demonstrate 5-7 years' experience in the maintenance, sustainment, and modernization of mission critical, electrical systems for the Navy. This position assembles and fabricates controllers, cable assemblies, connectors, and circuit boards in accordance with DOD technical instructions. Responsibilities include electrical testing, cable fabrication, troubleshooting, test reports, and building electronic components in support of the Naval Surface Warfare Center (NSWC PCD), Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) and Naval Experimental Diving Unit (NEDU).

Desire candidates with technical skills and previous experience (military or DOD) in electronic repairs and custom fabrication utilizing configuration mapping, wiring diagrams, machinery, power hand tools, soldering and a variety of calibrated electronics equipment. The assembly and testing of sub-systems are conducted off-base in the contractor's Depot Repair Facility (DRF) Electronics Lab. Potential applicants must be able to technically demonstrate electrical expertise in documented military projects, prototype designs, circuitry development and operation of electronic test sets. Proficiency in reading government technical data packages (TDP) to include drawings generated in AutoCAD or SolidWorks is required. Work orders will be issued and completed independently in accordance with statement of work and under the direction of Production Manager - Systems Engineer.

- Must have 5+ years direct experience as electrical and/or electronics technician
- Experienced in electrical assembly, cable fabrication, wiring harnesses, custom built electronic circuit boards and integration of electronic components.

- Experienced in potting connectors and cable assemblies
