Greenbush Township Regular Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the Greenbush Township Board was held August 3, 2015 at 7:00PM. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Jones and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. All board members were present.

Havens made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, Hayes supported and the motion carried.

Eric Thompson from the Sheriff Department reports a meth lab was recently found in Lebanon Township and suggested if you are going to be gone on vacation to let your neighbors know. You can also request the Department check on your property. Overall, it's a pretty quiet time of year.

Ed Jackson represented Beck & Fisher Case PC-25-15 MA Petition for Change of Zone - to amend an existing Planned Unit Development – Case PC-30-13 MA. Jones made a motion to allow the proposed amendment with time allowed to train emergency personnel should any disaster result from the placement of the two 60,000 gallon propane storage tanks near the existing car wash, Havens supported and the motion carried. The training will be conducted by Industrial Propane Service, Inc., the company that will be installing the tanks.

The minutes from the last meeting were read. Havens made a motion to approve them, Jones supported, and the motion carried.

Hayes made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as read, Smith supported, and the motion carried. Havens made a motion to pay orders #1276 thru #1285 for a total transfer of \$5,430.64 plus the Consumers invoice when it comes, Jorae supported and it carried.

Public Comment came from Lee Thelen concerning funding for road projects for this and next year, Kevin Kirk about getting car counts on some of our roads, Jean Bradley about chloride for next year and road side mowing, Jenny Jorae about the budget, and Julie Havens about the deputy treasurer providing a bond which is not required by the township board but is included with the bond covering the whole board paid for by the township.

Our County Commissioner, Kam Washburn spoke of water shed management and water quality. He states land use and development is taking place primarily in the South end of the county.

Havens made a motion to adjourn at 8:06 PM, Smith supported and the meeting adjourned.
