REMINDERS!

112. GARBAGE: (Article VIII, Section 7) No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste must be kept in sanitary, covered containers and placed in the trash enclosures. Garbage and/or refuse and recycling containers shall be stored behind wing walls where provided, or in an inconspicuous location on the property at all times, except on assigned days of garbage and/or refuse pick-up. Containers left at the curbside for more than 24 hours after pick-up shall be in violation of this rule and subject to a violation notice.

201. ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL: (Article V, Section (2)(a)) No building, fence, wall, wing wall, shed, playhouse or similar structure, or any other addition or modification to the existing property and structures shall be commenced prior to the owner submitting a site plan to the Environmental Control Committee for review, receiving committee approval and submitting copies of county permits (if applicable) prior to the start of the project.

202. EXISTING TREES AND LANDSCAPE: (Article V, Section 2(b)) No tree shall be removed prior to the owner submitting a site plan to the Environmental Control Committee for review, receiving committee approval and submitting copies of county permits prior to the start of the project.

ANIMALS: Dog runs are prohibited because they are in direct violation of the Covenants Article VIII, Section 6 Animals which requires that all pets must be controlled (maintained on a leash) at all times and not allowed to roam uncontrolled. All animal waste (droppings) MUST be picked up and disposed of. Barking dogs or other animal sounds are required to comply with the Noise ruling noted in Rule # 107
