Freeman W. Fankhauser, 82, of Harbor Beach, passed away Friday, January 30, 2004, at the Harbor Beach Community Hospital. He was born on August 20, 1921 in Port Hope, son of the late Albert and Agnes (Penner) Fankhauser. He married Alma Warczinsky on June 27, 1942 in St. John's Lutheran Church in Palms.
