

COVID-19 Emergency: Modified Allergy Immunotherapy Protocol

For patients receiving Allergy Shots (Immunotherapy) there will be a new protocol in place:

- In light of the recent Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, we kindly request if you are experiencing mild cold or flu-like symptoms such as fatigue, runny nose, and cough, to please remain home and refrain from visiting our offices as a precaution to prevent further transmission to others.
- Allergy injections may safely be postponed for several weeks if necessary
- Please refer to our **modified office hours** during the emergency
- For your protection, we are instituting a **strict social distancing and isolation policy** in the office
- A **limited number** of patients will be allowed in the waiting room at a given time
- Upon arrival, please give your name, date of birth and cell phone number – if the waiting room exceeds capacity, you will be asked to wait in your car until it is your turn
- By receiving your allergy injection, your verbal consent will be recorded
