The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to him in song (Psalm 28:7).

Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me (Psalm 51:12).

My lips will shout for joy when I sing praise to you – I, whom you have redeemed (Psalm 71:23).

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

When we think of *joy*, its meaning as used in the above three passages comes to mind. When we think about the Lord, our heart (should!) *leap for joy*. When we ponder our salvation, we are *joyful*. When we are in worship, *our lips should shout for joy!* 

On the other hand, there are a number of times in Scripture when the word is used, but under different circumstances. On Easter morning, after the women encounter the empty tomb, Matthew describes a different joy: So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples (Matthew 28:8).

Is it possible to be *afraid yet filled with joy?* Apparently so! The women were *joyful* that Jesus had been raised, but were afraid at such a prospect – a dead man suddenly alive (not to mention the earthquake and an angel descending from heaven!)

A more challenging example is from Jesus himself. At the Last Supper, Jesus says to his disciples: *I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete* (John 15:11). How could Jesus have any *joy*? He knew what he was facing – betrayal, arrest and execution! Later, as he prayed in the Garden, Jesus was NOT HAPPY! And yet he was *joyful!* How to explain this?

As Christians, we know from our own experiences *joy* is NOT always happiness. How many of us are sad when a loved one dies, yet we are *joyful* over a wonderful life lived. We praise God that a particular person was given to us as a family member or friend. We experience sadness and *joy* at the same time.

At the Last Supper, Jesus was not happy with what he faced, but he willingly and *joyfully* obeyed his Father's will. For our salvation, Jesus *joyfully* went to the Cross. The Letter to the Hebrews *joyfully* declares, Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God (Hebrews 12:2). Jesus saw the joy that lay ahead, and faithfully endured the Cross.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, on February 14, 2018, Ash Wednesday, I met many of you for the first time. As you might expect, I had been briefed extensively about Mars UP and her history. I must admit, I say I was a bit apprehensive about what I might be facing. But to my *joyful* surprise, as we celebrated the Sacrament of Communion, I looked at the large window in the back of the Sanctuary. As I looked, I was filled with *joy* over the work that lay ahead.

Of course, there have been a few days that have not been so good – some days, I have not been so happy. Maybe the same for you! Good and bad days, happy and not-so-happy days. But each and every day, I have had the *joy* of serving as your Pastor.

Amazingly enough, I have been called by God to serve, and for that, I am *joyful*. Yes, difficult days lie ahead, but let us remain *joyful* as we encounter each opportunity.

**One more thing** – I would like you to think about, and pray about, what I might call the "joy factor" in worship. When someone visits, what do they find? What is the "joy factor" they encounter? When folks meet us, do we present an attitude of "I-am-full-of-the-love-of-Christ-and-I-am-really-joyful-that-you-are-here!"

Or do folks experience something less?

Brothers and sisters in Christ, let us present Mars UP as a *joyful* Body of Christ! Let those who see us for the first time say to themselves, "What a *joyful* group of folks. They have something that I want!" Let our hearts *leap for joy as we give thanks to God in song*. Let us pray that God will *restore to us the joy of his salvation and grant us a willing spirit, to sustain me*.

Indeed, we are redeemed! Let our lips shout for joy when we sing praise to God.

Let us be joyful – much work and many steps lie ahead. But let us face each challenge with joyful hears and a unified Spirit.



Class Of 2019


