#### INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS: Please read carefully

- **Booth Space Fee**: (1) Table without electricity and 2 chairs \$45. Payment is due with application. **APPLICATION DEADLINE** (14 days before event) on **Saturday**, **June 15**, 2019.
- Space for the KAA-MaCC Vendors Alley is limited to 20 vendors.
- All table locations in the Vendors Alley will be pre-assigned.
  - You must provide your own signage, tripod, accessories, etc.
- Please provide a *detailed* description of your booth items on the application (attach an additional sheet if necessary) and attach photos of sample items.
  - > NO FOOD VENDORS: Due to logistics of food vendor set-up, no food vendors are eligible.
- All vendors must CHECK-IN between 11:00 a.m.-1:15 p.m. Due to safety issues, arrivals after 1:15 p.m., may forfeit pre-assigned booth location and be assigned an alternate location.
- KCS' policy prohibits all tobacco and alcohol products anywhere on school property and campus. NO alcoholic beverages, smoking or other use of tobacco will be allowed inside or outside the building.
- No vehicles are to be parked on walks or grass areas. All precautions should be taken to protect shrubs and grounds. All props and equipment brought in are to be removed at the conclusion of the rental. No alterations, removal, stapling, tacking or damage are allowed to the existing facility set-up. It is important to NOT park in designated parking spaces for staff or spaces allotted for handicapped parking. A handicap permit must be visibly displayed in the vehicle. Absolutely no unattended vehicles may be left on the school grounds the night before the event nor 6 hours before the event.
- Kannapolis City Schools uses video surveillance cameras to protect and monitor all of its facilities.
- Booths must be **completely set-up** by **1:30 p.m.** KAA-MaCC requests that all vendor booths remain open until **4:00 p.m.** Vendors will have from **4:30-5:00 p.m.** to pack-up. All vendors **must be off the school grounds** by **5:15 p.m.** *To prevent accident or injury, any vendor wishing to leave early MUST notify the KAA-MaCC Event Coordinator*. With permission, booths that can be packed-up and "walked-out" will be allowed to do so.
- > IMPORTANT: The vendor is responsible for leaving the vendor area in the condition that it was originally received, i.e. removal of all debris such as boxes and trash.
- Each applicant will receive an email/letter to confirm receipt of a completed application. **Approved vendor applications will be sent on/before June 15<sup>th</sup>** and will include a map and directions.
- This is an indoor event and will occur rain or shine!
- ALL VENDOR FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Payment methods include money-order, check (payable to KAA-MaCC, Inc.) or on the KAA-MaCC website (www.kaa-macc.org) via the DONATE button.
- > All vendors are required to fill out the Vendor Registration Application completely.
- A completed Vendor Registration Application (page 2/2 only) with payment must be **returned by Saturday**, June 15, 2019.
