## What is Dismissal?

Why do the catechumens, (adults preparing for baptism), leave Mass after the Liturgy of the Word and Homily? Dismissal is part of RCIA that has its roots in the early church history. Christians were persecuted and participation in the Eucharistic Celebration was understood to be only for those people who were fully initiated. Catechumens were not permitted to participate in the full Mass.

Dismissal is an opportunity to provide additional nourishment of the Word of God at a time when they cannot participate in the Eucharist.

The prayer for the catechumens describes beautifully *"My dear friends this community now sends you forth to reflect more deeply upon the Word of God which you have shared with us today. Be assured of our loving support and prayers for you. We look forward to the day when you will share fully in the Lord's Table."*
