Models are required for every practical application. This is your chance to create and practice the techniques you have been shown during the theory classes. Models are here for your development and should not obstruct in the application process. Models must arrive and leave at the scheduled time. It is the responsibility of students and artists to organise a model.

Where a model is unable to attend, with adequate notice SC Artistry will attempt to find a replacement model.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

The Makeup Certificate Course costs \$2384.00

Payment options are available. To secure your placement, you will need to make a 50% deposit 21 days prior to course commencement. The balance of your course is due 21 days prior to the course completion.

Payment of course fees can be made by cash, direct deposit or credit card. All payments made via credit card will incur a 4% surcharge per transaction. SC ARTISTRY does not accept Cheques or Money Orders 3. No refund for course fees paid - it is the policy of SC ARTISTRY NOT to issue refunds for any course fees paid.
