

# Déjà vu Couture Consignor Agreement

The Seller/Consignor has read, understands and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. All sales are final. No returns, refunds or credits will be given.
2. Items checked into a Déjà vu Couture event must meet the following criteria or be subject to removal from sales event:
  - Securely tag all items with a bar code generated by the [www.myconsignmentmanager.com](http://www.myconsignmentmanager.com) software
  - Prepare items according the requirements on the website ([www.dejavucouturesales.com](http://www.dejavucouturesales.com)).
  - Items have been checked and determined to be recall free by the consignor. The Seller is solely responsible for ensuring the sale items are in compliance with the guidelines and requirements of the Consumer Product Safety Commission and/or applicable industry standards.
  - All items are *clean* (no stains, holes, missing buttons, etc) and *functioning* (batteries included, no missing parts). The Seller is solely responsible for the quality and condition of all products they sell.
3. Seller agrees to hold harmless and make no claim against Déjà vu Couture, the lessors of the space where the sale is held, any volunteer or paid participants in the sale, or the insurer for any damage, theft or loss of any items consigned to Déjà vu Couture. Consignor assumes the risks of these events occurring by participating in the sale. Items, loose pieces and/or accessories found without a tag will be placed in a lost & found box. Consignors may re-claim these items at pick up. Items, loose pieces and accessories not claimed at consignor pick-up will be donated.
4. Seller agrees to waive any and all claims for personal injury resulting from participation in the sale, whatever cause, against Déjà vu Couture, the lessor/lessee of the space where the sale is held, any volunteer or paid participant of the sale, and the insurer of Déjà vu Couture.
5. Seller will receive 60% of the sales price of all items that sell, unless otherwise stated in sales promotions, volunteering commitments, or Déjà vu Couture discretion. However, seller will receive up to 75% of the sales price of all items if the seller agrees and fulfills their volunteer commitment. (5% per shift) Déjà vu Couture will act with diligence to mail profit checks within one month after the sale.
6. If seller selects "Discount" in the [www.myconsignmentmanager.com](http://www.myconsignmentmanager.com) online inventory system while creating a tag for an item that unsold item will be offered for sale on the last day of the sale at 50% of the original sale price.
7. Any unsold items that are not retrieved on the last day of the sale by 3pm will be donated to charity. Déjà vu Couture will not store any items after end of the sale.
8. All Sales are final. However, in the event a buyer returns an improperly functioning item, the consignor is responsible and will be charged 10% of the item and a credit card transaction fee if necessary.
