1910 - 1984

Marion (Gus) Carraway of Bay Port passed away Sunday, Aug. 26 at St. Luke's Hospital, Saginaw, following a one-year illness.

He was born Aug. 10, 1910 in Scotland Neck, N.C. On July 28, 1943, he was united in marriage to Miss Ellen A. Drechsler in Detroit. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was employed at the Statler-Hilton Hotel in Detroit for 30 years, before retiring in 1965 and moving to Bay Port in 1966.
