Micah 4:1 — ¹ *And it will come about in the last days That the mountain of the house of the Lord Will be established as the chief of the mountains. It will be raised above the hills, And the peoples will stream to it.”*

Though I fall I will rise; Though I dwell in darkness, the Lord is a light for me. ⁹ I will bear the indignation of the Lord Because I have sinned against Him, Until He pleads my case and executes justice for me. He will bring me out to the light, And I will see His righteousness."*
