

Stretching across two-and-a-half miles (four kilometers) and plunging 269 feet (82 meters) down into the Iguaçu River, this magnificent display of more than 240 separate waterfalls is a site to behold. Iguaçu Falls is located along southern Brazil's border with Argentina, and in 1986 UNESCO declared the falls "a natural heritage of mankind."

DAY 1: APRIL 5, 2020

Q Iguaçu Falls, Brazil

After breakfast at the hotel this morning, you will depart for the airport for your short flight to Iguaçu Falls. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your local hotel.

You will have some time to check in with lunch on your own this afternoon.


Long before the Spanish explorer Don Alvar Nuñes reached South America's greatest waterfall in 1541, the local Indians had named it **Iguaçu**—*meaning great waters*. There is no more fitting description, as thousands of visitors to Iguassú each year will testify. Once seen, the falls—all 275 of them—are never forgotten.





From the **Iguaçu National Park** main gate to the top of the trail leading to the falls—a 25km drive through pristine Atlantic Forest lush vegetation. The trail going down the Iguaçu river canyon is pleasant as it opens, here and there, to the spectacle of more than 240 falls that form the horseshoeshaped Iguaçu Falls. Reaching the bottom, a lookout takes you to the edge with waters circling around. A glass elevator moves you slowly up the cliff face for an exquisite view at the upper deck. The water volume is staggering and when the waters are high—sheer emotion! Brazil shares Iguaçu Falls with Argentina and on both sides a National park protects the rainforest that surrounds this marvel! UNESCO has declared Iguaçu Falls and both parks a National Heritage Site of Brazil and Argentina

Transfer to the **Macuco trail** in the Iguaçu National Park, where board jeeps, the best form of transport in this rain forest because the road we take is unpaved but accessible the year round. You will learn about several different species of sub-tropical plants and trees, including orchids and the heart-of-palm, which grow in abundance here. With luck, animals and some of the beautiful birds of the region may be sighted. After a jeep ride of 3 km, continue for 600 meters on foot to the picturesque **Macuco Falls**, hidden in the forested canyon.



The trail brings you to the banks of the Iguaçu River, where you will **board twin-engine inflatable boats** (capacity: 25 passengers each), specially designed for the local river conditions. Cruise up into the Iguaçu canyon, shoot several rapids, and arrive to the very base of the majestic waterfalls. As the experienced pilot maneuvers in the midst of the falls, the passenger will have a completely different view and experience a thrill never forgotten. Guaranteed spray and getting wet by the falls.

Meals: Breakfast

DAY 2: APRIL 6, 2020

After breakfast at the hotel, cross the Ponte da Fraternidade (Fraternity Bridge) over the Iguaçu River, which forms the border between Argentina and Brazil. The visit of the **Argentinean Falls** starts at the central station of the ecologic tourist train. From there, the little train brings the visitors very close to the famous devil's throat, where the visitors walk the last 1200 meters on a gangway to look right into the throat. Then, the train returns to the central station, from where visitors will discover the sights of the upper circuit by walking (approx. 45 minutes).

Lunch will be provided at a local restaurant this afternoon.

On the way back to the hotel, pass by the landmark of the three borders, where Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay meet.

Dinner is on your own this evening back at the hotel.

DAY 3: APRIL 7, 2020

This morning, you can take time to relax in your beautiful surroundings before checking out of the hotel.

You will transfer to the airport for your return flight to the U.S. Transit via Sao Paulo International Airport late this afternoon for your flight back to the U.S. this evening.

Arrive back in the U.S. is the following morning (April 8, 2020).
