**Highlights:** Tournaments in Oct, Nov, Dec

San Diego County Women's Golf Association is excited to welcome you back to our tournaments. The **Memorial Tournament** held at St. Mark on September 21 was a great success with 84 players participating. And the American Cancer Society was a winner with the donations contributed by SDCWGA members! The tournament winners are listed below.

Following the guidelines of health authorities, SDCWGA is now holding tournaments with limited capacity – mostly determined by the number of carts available for our use. Each of us plays a role in keeping our tournaments safe and we thank you for your cooperation.

Coming up on October 19th is a **Field Day** at Steele Canyon. SDCWGA has 18 teams of 4 playing there!

This was a big disappointment since this is one of our most popular tournaments. However, another **Field Day** was scheduled at Bernardo Heights on **November 16**—with 60 players invited to sign up to play in 4-Ball (Better Ball of Partners) format.

The **Holiday Event** at Lomas Santa Fe is scheduled again this year—on **December 7** with a limit of 64 players.
