## Greenbush Township Board Meeting

The regular meeting of the Greenbush Township Board was held the 1st of July 2013 at 7:00PM. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Jim Jorae and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. All board members were present.

Bernadette Hayes made a motion to accept the agenda, Julie Havens supported and the motion carried.

Minutes from the June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2013 board meeting were read. Bill Dershem made a motion to accept the minutes as read, Julie Havens supported and the motion carried.

The Treasurers report was presented. The balances on June 30<sup>th</sup> 20-13 were: Citizens Bank Checking: \$ 253.85 Citizens Bank Savings: \$ 60,995.41 Firstbank MMIA: \$ 8,415.91 Tax MMIA: \$ 2,931.27 Total Funds Available: \$ 72,596.44 Bill Dershem made a motion to accept the report as read, supported by Bernadette Hayes and it carried. Bill Dershem made a motion to transfer \$48,851.71 to pay orders 783 through 798 and to pay the Consumers bill for the Eureka Street lights and the Township hall estimated at \$350, when it comes, Bernadette Hayes supported and the motion carried.

Public comment came from Jean Bradley concerning the Township land on Silvers Road.

Eric Thompson from the Clinton County Sheriff Department reports car/deer accidents are up again and increased patrols in the Eureka area have produced multiple stop sign violations. Our County officers are receiving meth lab training.

Assessor Gail Watkins says there will not be a Board of Review held this summer as there were no issues to be resolved. A random audit of the minimum assessing requirements is being done for all of Clinton County. After serving as our assessor since 1998, Gail announced his retirement effective at the end of August.
