CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Richard Rumpf called the meeting to order at 5:02 pm.

PRESENT: Mayor Richard Rumpf, Trustee Harvan Conrad, Trustee James Nelson, Trustee Clark Brown, and Carleen Gomez–Deputy Clerk

PARTICIPATING VIA ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCE: Trustee Donna Dawson (5:05 pm) and Micheal Steininger - Village Finance Officer

GUESTS: Juanita Puente Brown, Michael Thompson, Aimee Thompson, Fritz Kapraun, Michael Zamora-Magdalena Marshal, Brian Waterman-Lieutenant, Catherine DeMaria and Collier J. Nelson-Assistant Clerk

Brian Waterman led the gallery in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Clark Brown moved to approve the agenda, and Harvan Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- a. **REGULAR MEETING JULY 24, 2023:** James Nelson moved to approve the minutes as amended, and Harvan Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **b. SPECIAL MEETING JULY 31, 2023:** James Nelson moved to approve the minutes as presented, and Clark Brown seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF CASH BALANCE REPORT: Donna Dawson moved to approve the Cash Balance Report, and Clark Brown seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Deputy Clerk Carleen Gomez stated that there was no Bill List available at this meeting. She stated that if anyone would like to see any of the bills, they were more than welcome to come in and review them.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Rumpf thanked everyone who helped with last week's power outage. He stated that the Socorro Electric Cooperative deserves a big thank you for all that they did. He stated that they worked long hard hours. He stated that we got generators for the water tanks and thanked everyone in the community for conserving water. He thanked the Utility crew for consistently checking on the water tank levels. Mayor Rumpf reported that the Fire Department received \$105,553.00 and made a fire truck payment

of \$17,000.00 and the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) fourth quarter report and budget was accepted and approved.

CLERK'S REPORT: Deputy Clerk Carleen Gomez stated that the Auditor's have rescheduled, and they will be at Village Hall the week of September 26th 2023.

- a. EMS: James Nelson reported that there were 6 EMS calls in July 2023.
- b. FIRE: Mayor Richard Rumpf stated that there were 4 or 5 Fire calls in July 2023.
- c. MARSHAL: A report was submitted by Marshal Michael Zamora and reviewed by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.

- e. PUBLIC WORKS: Mayor Richard Rumpf stated that Joint Utility Worker Ezekiel Gomez was working with Jake Finch.
- f. LIBRARY: A report was submitted by Librarian Yvonne Magener and reviewed by the Mayor and Board of Trustees.

DISCUSSION & POSSIBLE DECISION REGARDING APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. 2023-18, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A LOAN AGREEMENT AND INTERCEPT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN VILLAGE OF MAGDALENA, NEW MEXICO (THE "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT") AND NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY (THE "FINANCE AUTHORITY"), EVIDENCING A SPECIAL, LIMITED OBLIGATION OF THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT TO PAY A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$54,358.85 TOGETHER WITH INTEREST THEREON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A NEW POLICE VEHICLE AND THE RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT; PROVIDING FOR THE PLEDGE AND PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST DUE UNDER THE LOAN AGREEMENT SOLELY FROM THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT PROTECTION FUND REVENUES DISTRIBUTED BY THE STATE TREASURER TO THE GOVERNMENTAL UNIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-13-6, NMSA 1978; PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT PROTECTION FUND REVENUES TO BE REDIRECTED BY THE STATE TREASURER TO THE FINANCE AUTHORITY OR ITS ASSIGNS FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST DUE ON THE LOAN AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO AN INTERCEPT AGREEMENT: APPROVING THE FORM AND TERMS OF, AND OTHER DETAILS CONCERNING THE LOAN AGREEMENT AND INTERCEPT AGREEMENT; SETTING THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE OF THE LOAN; RATIFYING ACTIONS HERETOFORE TAKEN; REPEALING ALL ACTION INCONSISTENT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; AND AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF THE LOAN AGREEMENT AND INTERCEPT AGREEMENT: Trustee Donna Dawson asked what kind of vehicle the loan was for. Ms. Catherine DeMaria stated that this is designed to benefit the for-profit art businesses. This is a new Grant that was issued at 50% to rural communities. She stated that the Village's Art scene is on their radar. She stated that 8-10% will be allocated for administration of the Grant and a budget will be submitted with the Grant application. Harvan Conrad moved to approve proceeding with applying for the \$100,000.00 Creative Industries Grant application, and James Nelson seconded the motion.
