ORDINANCE 39C (Amended)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS, SUPERCEDING ORDINANCE 39C, PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARK RULES AND RV PARK RULES AS ESTABLISHED BY THE LOG CABIN POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND BY THE LOG CABIN CITY COUNCIL, PROVIDING FOR SEGREGATED HOURS OF OPERATION BY AREA, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, use of the Park facilities must provide for the health, safety and welfare of the public at large, it is therefore deemed necessary for the City Council to adopt this City Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: ENACTING CLAUSE

Ordinance 39 of the City of Log Cabin, known as the park rules ordinance, together with all amendments and revisions thereto, is hereby superseded in entirety by this Park Operations Ordinance, #39 C (amended).

The provisions of this ordinance support and supplement, and in no way diminish or conflict with other City Ordinances providing specific regulation for park operations.

SECTION 2: ENFORCEMENT OF CITY ORDINANCE

The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to implement the enforcement of this ordinance, upon determination that implementation is necessary, to protect the public welfare and safety.

SECTION 3: APPLICATION OF CITY ORDINANCE

The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all persons, firms, groups, organizations, corporations, residence and visitors to the City's park facilities.

SECTION 4: AREA DEFINITIONS

Picnic Area - the area from Park Way going southeast to the water's edge, from the Daniel's Point fence to Pelican Point fence, is designated the picnic area with the exception of the boat launch area.

Boat Launch Area - the area from Park Way going southeast to the end of the boat slip and walkway on the dock, limited to the paved parking area.

Fishing Pier Area - the fishing pier is the horseshoe pier attached to the southwest side of the picnic area.

Camping Area - the area from Wyatt Earp moving southeast to Park Way, from Alamo Road moving northeast to the creek bed near the Red Barn.

SECTION 5: HOURS OF OPERATION

Fishing Pier and Boat Launch Area are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Picnic and Swimming Areas – Park hours are 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m., 7 days a week.

******EXCEPTION******: Park may be opened earlier or later when fishing tournaments or special events are scheduled.

SECTION 6: PARK RULES

1. All pets must be on a leash.
2. **No alcohol, illegal drugs or glass bottles allowed in park.**
3. **No firearms & weapons allowed.**
4. No diving or jumping from piers.
5. No running or reckless endangerment (pushing, shoving, etc.)
6. **No skateboards, roller blades or bikes in the picnic or swimming area.**
7. No loud, profane or abusive language in a public place.
8. No overnight camping.
9. No open ground fires.
10. No littering.
11. No fireworks.
12. No children under **15** years of age without adult supervision.
13. Boat trailer parking in designated area only.

Subsection 6 (A):

By voluntarily entering the City Park, all persons and/or vehicles are subject to the inspection of all containers, ice chests, etc by Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of detecting alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, glass bottles or any other items or substances prohibited in the City Park under Ordinance 39C.

SECTION 7: RV PARK RULES

1. Check-out time is **2:00 p.m.** unless prior arrangements are made with the office.
2. All pets must be on a leash.
3. RV spots allow for one **(1)** vehicle and one **(1)** boat – additional are \$5.00 each.
4. No children allowed at lake area under the age of **15** without adult supervision.
5. All visitors must park in designated area.
6. **Illegal Drugs, Loud, Profane or Abusive Language or Fireworks are not allowed.**

SECTION 8: PENALTY

Any person, firm, group, organization, corporation, resident or visitor violating a rule of the park shall be deemed guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine, not to exceed \$500.00, as determined by the Log Cabin Municipal Court.

Unauthorized vehicles and/or persons found in the park after closing will be subject to removal at the discretion of the Police.

THE CITY OF LOG CABIN ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR ACCIDENTS THAT MAY OCCUR ON THE PREMISES.

ALL CITY, TARRANT COUNTY WATER BOARD, STATE OF TEXAS AND TEXAS PARKS & WILDLIFE ORDINANCES AND LAWS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE LOG CABIN POLICE DEPARTMENT OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

VANDALISM AND CRIMINAL MISCHIEF OF ANY PARK FACILITY COULD RESULT IN IMMEDIATE ARREST.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
