

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2017-34

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MAYOR'S COMPENSATION
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Section 4.05 of the Charter of Amelia Village allows Village Council to establish the amount of compensation to be provided to the Mayor as an elected official for the duties he performs in this role, and

WHEREAS, Amelia Village does not currently have a Village Administrator; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Village Council to adjust the compensation provided to Todd Hart as an elected official for the duties he performs while serving as Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Pursuant to section 4.05 of the Charter of Amelia Village, Village Council authorizes the annual payment of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) to be paid to Todd Hart as an elected official for the duties he performs in the role of Mayor beginning January 1, 2018 and continuing for the remainder of his elected term.

SECTION II. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is that this will allow for such payment without disruption to the Mayor's duties, or the orderly operation of Amelia Village. Therefore, provided this emergency Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.
