At the request of Supervisor Miller, could you please provide the following information relative to the Loop:

1. A list of the public art funded using:
  - a. Any portion of the one percent of the Pima County Public Art Program established as a result of the 1990 policy approved by the Supervisors; and
  - b. Of these projects identified and funded, as such, the
    1. Cost of the individual artwork; and
    2. Identified funding source as a percentage or amount of funding by funding source for that respective art piece (i.e., HURF, Bonds, Flood Control District, etc.); and
    3. The Project ID (CIP number or otherwise) associated with each public art work, and to which funding source the expense was debited.

This request does not include any artwork that was funded 100% from donations outside of county resources. However, if any artworks were funded by both county and private donations, please include those artworks in the list. For clarification, I am specifically referring to those art projects referenced in the September 12, 2018 press release, "New art map, webpage showcases art along shared-use path," and which lists your name as the contact for requesting further information.
