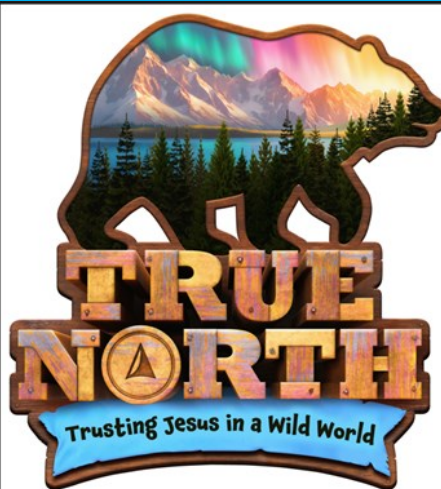

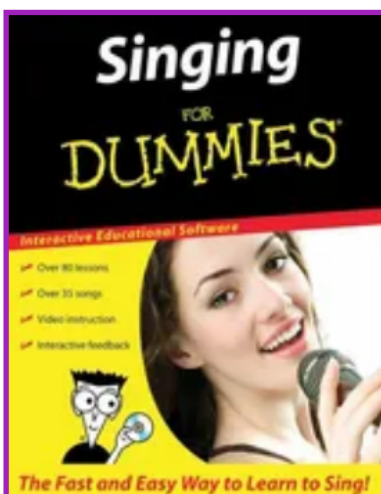
There is NO COST, but spaces are limited—so don't wait!

Discussing the Readings with your children



What is a martyr?

A martyr is a person who suffers death rather than give up his or her religion.

When St. Peter proclaims that Jesus is the Messiah, Jesus says that Peter could not have said this on his own, but that God had revealed it to him. St. Paul, awaiting his end on earth, faces it with hope because he believes that God had always been beside him in his work. After a life of guidance by the Spirit, St. Paul feels unafraid in the face of his martyrdom. His hope is in God.

The Holy Spirit's work is most visibly expressed in the first reading when an angel helps rescue Peter from prison. Both St. Peter and St. Paul were guided by the Spirit. They are models for us because they responded to that call with their whole hearts.

Most of us will never be martyrs. But we all have a special call from God. We are called not to live for ourselves, but to offer our lives as a gift. For St. Peter and St. Paul, their lives were offered as a gift over and over throughout their lives. They were offered one final time in their lives.

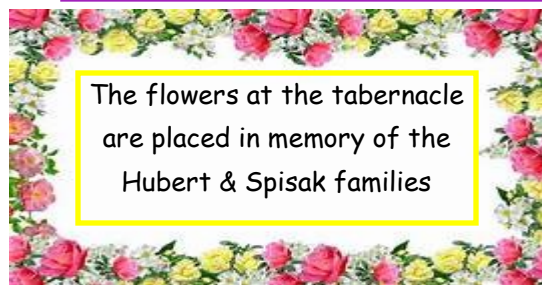
