Clyde H. Schamel, 96, of Caseville and Florida, died Friday, Dec. 13, 2002, at the home of his daughter in Florida while under hospice care. He was born March 15, 1906 in Buffalo, N.Y. to the late John and Bertha (Farrell) Schamel. He was united in marriage to Ruth Onetto on Oct. 30, 1929 in Notre Dame, Indiana.
