## Northeast College Tour: June 22 - 29, 2019

## **Tour Description:**

This eight day / seven night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities where you will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, and have an exciting and educational time with peers and new friends.

You will visit: Boston University, Northeastern University, Babson College, or Harvard University; Tufts University, MIT, Boston College, or Bentley University; Brown University, Rhode Island School of Design, or Bryant University; Yale University or Quinnipiac University; Fordham University, Columbia University, or Barnard College; New York University, Parsons School of Design, or Pace University; University of Pennsylvania, Drexel University, or Swarthmore College; Haverford College, Bryn Mawr College, or Villanova University; Johns Hopkins University, Goucher College, Maryland Institute College of Art, or Loyola University Maryland; Georgetown University or George Washington University; American University, University of Maryland, or Washington, DC Tour. There will be student led campus tours, meetings with admission officers, campus meals, activities, and plenty of sightseeing. Lodging will occur in hotels located near the schools and is based on double occupancy. Activities on previous tours have included exploring the areas surrounding the schools, attending special events, and shopping in malls and markets. Throughout the trip, participants receive helpful information, materials, and tips on how to make the most of the campus visits.

The tour will be led by Robert Rummerfield, Director of **COLLEGE VISITS** and High School Counselors. Before starting **COLLEGE VISITS**, Mr. Rummerfield was an admissions officer at The Johns Hopkins University. Since 1991, teenagers, parents, and counselors from across the world have joined our tours. Some of their comments:
