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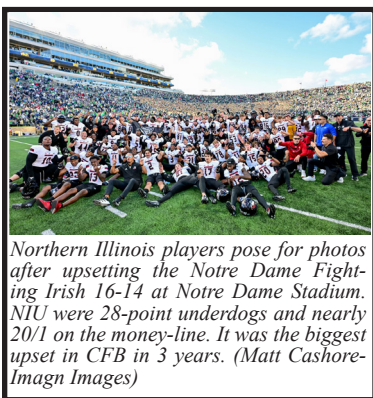

Misleading Finals

Oklahoma State (-10) beat Arkansas 39-31 in double overtime. However, Arkansas had a 648-385 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. Arkansas led 14-0 and were looking for more and then the key play happened with Oklahoma State getting a 73-yard "Pick 6" to get them back in the game.

Toledo (-17.5) beat Massachusetts 38-23. Umass had a 384-258 yard edge.

FIU (+3.5) crushed Central Michigan 52-16. However, CMU actually had a 369-309 yard edge. CMU was -6 in TO's.

Washington State (+2.5) beat Texas Tech 37-16. However, Texas Tech had a 491-416 yard edge but the Red Raiders were -3 in TO's.

California (+12) upset Auburn 21-14. However, Cal had a +5 TO margin.

Kansas State (-8.5) beat Tulane 34-27. However, Tulane had a 491-396 yard edge in the game but were -2 in TO's.

Illinois (+5.5) upset Kansas 23-17. However, Kansas had a 327-271 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

Syracuse (+3) beat Georgia Tech 31-28. The Cuse actually led 31-14 in the 4Q.

Clemson (-17) beat Appalachian State 66-20. It was 56-13 at halftime!

Pitt (+1.5) beat Cincinnati 28-27. Pitt trailed 27-6 late 3Q.

Connecticut (-14.5) beat Merrimack 63-17. It was 56-7 at halftime!

Liberty (-22) beat New Mexico State 30-24. New Mexico State actually led 24-15 in the middle of the 4Q.

Alabama (-30.5) beat USF 42-16. However, Alabama only led 21-16 in the middle of the 4Q.

Bad Beats

Duke upset Northwestern 26-20 in double overtime. The opening number on the total at Circa Sunday morning was 45.5 and it was bet down to 37.5 at close. Northwestern led 13-10 in the final minute of the 4Q. Duke had an opportunity inside the 10-yard line to score a TD and win the game but settled for a FG that sent the game to OT. Both teams scored quick TD's in the first OT and then Duke scored another TD in the second overtime to put the game over all numbers.

Missouri (-32) beat Buffalo 38-0. Instead of taking a knee, Missouri scored a TD with :33 left.

The total in the William & Mary and Coastal Carolina game was 54.5. William & Mary scored a TD with :06 left to put the game OVER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Arizona State 31 TEXAS STATE 29. We've upgraded Arizona State as much as any team so far. Their defense is much improved (No. 13 in ypg) and they still have RB Skattebo who is No. 3 in the nation with 311 rushing yards. They're playing a Texas State team that is off an impressive 49-10 win over UTSA and a win here could see the Bobcats favored in every game down the stretch. We don't see much value but definitely is one of the most intriguing games this week.

Friday, September 13th

† **Kansas 33 UNLV 24.** @Children's Mercy Park in Kansas City. Re-match of last year's Guaranteed Rate Bowl which Kansas won 49-36 (-7.5). UNLV is 2-0 and their 24-7 win over Houston in week 1 aged well after the Cougars almost upset Oklahoma last week. Speaking of upsets, Kansas lost at Illinois as the Jayhawks were -3 in TO's. We think they rebound.

KANSAS STATE 33 Arizona 25. Despite being in the same conference this year, this is a non-conference game and won't count in the Big 12 standings. We haven't been overly impressed with either team so far as while the two teams are both 2-0, they are a combined 0-4 ATS. Arizona has gotten off to slow starts (outscored a combined 34-33 at halftime so far) despite being huge favorites in both games. Meanwhile Kansas State should have lost last week to Tulane. Kansas St has shown us a little more up front (+9 in sacks vs Arizona +1).

Saturday, September 14th

Oklahoma State 42 TULSA 22. Oklahoma State comes off the thrilling 2OT win over Arkansas. However, Oklahoma State was outgained by 263 yards but got a crucial long "Pick 6" when down 14-0 that got them back in the game. Meanwhile, Tulsa blew a 10-point halftime lead vs Arkansas State. This could be a tricky spot for OSU.

TEXAS TECH 40 North Texas 29. Both offenses are averaging more than 500 ypg but Texas Tech's defense is also allowing more than 500 ypg and 44 ppg. The Red Raiders are down several starters and we've seen the market move against them. However, they were better than the final last week as they were -3 in TO's. This is a must-win for Tech or their season could get much worse in a competitive Big 12.

Alabama 32 WISCONSIN 18. Alabama has only played 4 true non-conference road games since 2007 and this is their first trip to Big Ten country since 2011. Statistically, Alabama has looked the part so far under DeBoer as they are No. 9 in ypp margin. However, last week's 42-16 final was misleading as the Crimson Tide only led USF 21-16 mid-way through the 4Q. Wisconsin has had two workman-like 14-point wins (non-covers) vs Western Michigan and South Dakota. While our ratings lean Wisconsin, we need a +17 to show.

ILLINOIS 34 Central Michigan 17. A classic "inside-out" handicap. On one side, you have Illinois off an upset win where they benefited from +3 TO's vs Kansas in game they were out-gained. On the other side, you have CMU off an upset loss to FIU where they were -6 in TO's in a game they lost by 36 but had the yardage edge. We like CMU.

FLORIDA STATE 30 Memphis 24. FSU became only the 3rd team since 1990 to lose their first two games outright as a double-digit favorite. Neither game was a fluke as FSU is getting out-gained 453-119 on the ground so far. However, they come in off a much-needed bye. Mike Norvell is coaching against the team he led to 3 straight AAC Championship games. We think FSU gets a win but it won't be easy.

Cincinnati 26 MIAMI, OH 23. Miami broke their 16-game losing streak in this series last year despite getting out-gained by 180 yards. The Redhawks come in off a bye after losing to Northwestern. Meanwhile, Cincinnati comes in off the shocking loss to Pittsburgh where the Bearcats blew a 27-6 3Q lead. Cincy coach Scott Satterfield desperately needs a win here.

NC STATE 38 Louisiana Tech 14. It's been an extremely disappointing start for NC State who is 0-2 ATS failing to cover by an average of 24 ppg. Last week, they were embarrassed by Tennessee. They need to get right here vs LT who is off a bye. We lean Wolf Pack.

Lsu 31 SOUTH CAROLINA 22. We're stunned at LSU's inability to run the ball (64 yards vs Nicholls last week) as the Tigers were supposed to have one of the best OL in the country. Equally as stunning was South Carolina's 31-6 upset of Kentucky last week as 9.5-point underdogs. SC's offense leaves a lot to be desired though ranking No. 124 in yards per play and LSU has a big QB edge here.

MICHIGAN 37 Arkansas State 13. Michigan comes in off the humbling 31-12 loss to Texas where the Wolverines were manhandled at the line of scrimmage in the first half (trailed 24-3). Arkansas State is a phony 2-0 straight but are 0-2 ATS as they are -1.3 in yards per play margin (No. 115). A "get right" game here for Michigan.

MISSOURI 34 Boston College 18. Both teams are 2-0 ATS. Missouri hasn't allowed a single point so far this season and are only allowing 127 ypg. They've only played Murray State and Buffalo. Meanwhile, BC's defense ranks in the Top 20 in ypp, ypg and ppg. The Eagles are running a slow tempo under Bill O'Brien (No. 130 in plays per minute) and we think that keeps this one somewhat close.

BUFFALO 26 Massachusetts 21. Both teams deserved a bit better last week as UMass actually had a 384-258 yard edge vs Toledo. Missouri then scored a TD in the final seconds to cover vs Buffalo. This will be a conference game next year. Early money has been on UMass but we haven't got involved yet.

Coastal Carolina 34 TEMPLE 18. Coastal is 2-0 ATS while Temple is 0-2 ATS. There's not much you can hang your hat on if you're Temple as the Owls are -37.5 in scoring margin (No. 133). They haven't protected the football as they are dead last in TO margin at -9. We've seen early money on Coastal this week but we're not involved.

Texas A&M 27 FLORIDA 23. A really important game for both teams. Both suffered humbling Week 1 home losses and rebounded vs over-matched FCS opponents last week. Will Florida play both QB's Graham Mertz and DJ Lagway here? Mertz should return after missing last week, but Lagway certainly impressed. We don't see much value.

† **Washington 31 Washington State 25.** @Lumen Field in Seattle, WA. Despite no longer being in the same conference, we're glad to see the Apple Cup being played. Both teams are 2-0 and both have impressed. Washington has been more dominant than the final scores as they are No. 8 in ypp margin (+4.5). Meanwhile, Washington State's offense ranks No. 2 in yards per play and QB John Mateur nearly ran for 200 yards last week. We lean UW here at the current numbers.

Oregon 34 OREGON STATE 18. Despite a 2-0 record, we're not sure if there has been a more disappointing team in the country than the Ducks who have failed to cover their two games by an average of 27 ppg. Last year Oregon allowed 5 sacks all season...this year...7 already! Oregon State is quietly 2-0 and +220 ypg as they have dominated opponents up front out-rushing them by a combined 599-154 so far.

West Virginia 31 PITTSBURGH 28. The Backyard Brawl is yet another rivalry game this Saturday. The new Pitt offense has been exciting averaging 534 ypg and came alive in last week's 4Q comeback at Cincinnati. The Panthers are No. 3 in the country in plays per minute. Keep an eye on RB Desmond Reid who leads the nation in all purpose yards. After already losing to Penn State, WVU needs this one.

MIAMI, FL 47 Ball State 12. We like OVER here. Ball State a fundamentally different team this year. Last year, the defense allowed just 13.6 ppg and 257 ypg their last 7 games. This year the defense returns only 1 starter. Last year their offense averaged 18.6 ppg and just 83 passing ypg in their last 6 games. This year's offense has 8 returning starters. Plus, Miami is much better at QB this year.

OKLAHOMA 34 Tulane 18. Oklahoma's offense has been a mess so far averaging just 313 ypg against Temple and Houston. We heard rumors that QB Jackson Arnold did not look good this fall camp and that has carried over to the season. Meanwhile, Tulane should have upset Kansas State last week (491-396 yard edge) and their QB Darian Mensah has played well (70% completions). The early week money has been on Tulane but our power ratings are strong on OU here.

MINNESOTA 31 Nevada 14. We've upgraded Nevada more than any team in the country so far this season. However, this is a tough spot for them after 3 straight games decided by 5 points or less. We think Minnesota's big OL will wear them down in the second half.

Notre Dame 26 PURDUE 17. Just when everyone penciled in ND for the playoffs after the Texas A&M win, the Irish suffered the biggest upset loss in CFB in 3 years. Meanwhile, Purdue has been game-planning for this game all summer after playing an FCS opponent and a bye. ND QB Leonard is not 100% and the Irish have completed just 1 pass of more than 20 yards this year (dead last). Early week money has been on Purdue and we agree.

Appalachian State 30 EAST CAROLINA 28. App State was destroyed last week as they trailed Clemson 56-13 at halftime. They're 0-2 ATS on the season while ECU is somehow 2-0 ATS despite a -6 TO margin. ECU has been impressive in the stats ranking No. 20 in ypp margin and No. 12 in ypg margin and their offense ranks No. 4 in yards per minute. We would have liked ECU a lot here but the App St result last week sucked the value out of the market.

IOWA 31 Troy 9. Iowa could have a much better team this year and not come close to matching last year's 10 wins. Last week, they looked like they were in total control at halftime but lost to rival Iowa State 20-19. We're not sure any team in the country will take a bigger step back in W/L record than Troy this year who is already 0-2.

ARKANSAS 42 Uab 20. Arkansas comes in off the heart-breaking loss to Oklahoma State where they had a 263 yardage edge. Bobby Petrino has certainly improved the offense as they are No. 2 in the country averaging 667 ypg. Meanwhile, UAB comes in off a shocking 32-6 loss to ULM as 11-point favorites. We could see this being the final season for Trent Dilfer.

Utah 34 UTAH STATE 13. Obviously, the story here is the health of Utah QB Cam Rising who likely won't play here after suffering a hand injury in last week's game vs Baylor. Isaac Wilson will probably get the start here. The Utes should still not have any problems vs a Utah State team that lost 48-0 to USC last week and their QB situation hasn't been great on the injury front either.

Virginia Tech 33 OLD DOMINION 19. VT got a bounce back win last week over Marshall but still didn't cover the 3-TD spread. The ODU offense has been a mess. Despite running a fast tempo (No. 6), the Monarchs are No. 125 in ypp and won't be able to keep up here.

LIBERTY 41 Utep 17. It hasn't gotten a lot of publicity but Liberty has been really disappointing this season. Despite a 2-0 record, the Flames are 0-2 ATS failing to cover by 19.5 ppg. Last week they trailed New Mexico State 24-15 in the 4Q before rallying. This is another big favorite role here. However, UTEP is off an upset loss to FCS Southern Utah and is transitioning under a new coach.

DUKE 33 Connecticut 16. Duke got a big 2OT win at Northwestern last week. Manny Diaz defense ranks No. 9 in ypp allowed and No. 15 in ypg allowed. UConn's offense looked much better last week. We bet Duke early in the week but don't see much value at current..

FLORIDA ATLANTIC 26 Fiu 20. The Shula Bowl. This is a very important game for FAU head coach Tom Herman. The Owls are 0-2 and were destroyed last week at the line of scrimmage as Army had a 405-42 rushing yardage. Meanwhile, FIU had a very misleading 36-point win over CMU as they were +6 in TO's.

Ole Miss 43 WAKE FOREST 20. While they have played a couple of tomato cans, Ole Miss' offense ranks No. 1 in yards per play averaging 9.2, No. 1 in ypg averaging 713 and No. 1 in scoring averaging 64. Wake comes off the heart-breaking loss to Virginia. Both teams are top 10 in terms of plays per minute. That's why

Western Kentucky 31 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 23. Both teams are 1-1. Both got crushed vs SEC teams and both got wins over FCS teams this season. We trust WKU a little more with this being the first year for Derek Mason at MTSU.

Jacksonville State 26 EASTERN MICHIGAN 25. Jacksonville State is 0-2 straight up and 0-2 ATS. Their defense ranks dead last allowing 52 ppg and rank 2nd to last allowing 581 ypg. They've been outgained by 257 ypg so far. However, our power ratings like them.

Vanderbilt 30 GEORGIA STATE 20. Vanderbilt is 2-0 and have covered both games by an average of 21 ppg. Now comes a much different test as the Commodores haven't been a double-digit road favorite since 2013. We prefer the OVER here. Despite, Vandy's slow tempo, they've been efficient and Georgia State's defense ranks No. 128 in ypp allowed.

TEXAS 43 Utsa 11. Texas is 2-0 ATS and off the most impressive win any team has had this year. The Longhorns man-handled the Wolverines at the line of scrimmage in the first half. QB Quinn Ewers is now the Heisman favorite. UTSA is 0-2 ATS and were crushed by Texas State last week as short underdogs. Easy cover for Texas right? We lean UTSA.

SAM HOUSTON STATE 27 Hawaii 24. The market loves Sam Houston State this year. Last week the money was wrong in their 45-14 loss at UCF. While we originally bet Sam Houston St, at the current numbers we would lean with Hawaii. Hawaii is off a bye, and have the better ypp, ypg and ppg margins.

South Florida 34 SOUTHERN MISS 21. How could you not be impressed with USF last week? The Bulls only trailed Alabama by 5 midway through the 4Q in what was a misleading final. Meanwhile, Southern Miss' 31-0 loss to Kentucky in the opener didn't age well with the Wildcats getting embarrassed last week. We bet USF on the open and still lean USF.

MISSISSIPPI STATE 35 Toledo 26. Both teams are in the Top 20 in plays per minute. While Mississippi State didn't cover last week, we were impressed that they didn't lay down vs Arizona State as they trailed 30-3 only to lose 30-23. Toledo is off a misleading win vs UMass. Early week money has been on Miss St.

AUBURN 46 New Mexico 17. Auburn is off a shocking loss to Cal where they were -5 in TO's. The Auburn offense should get right here vs a New Mexico defense that is the worst in the country. The Lobos

rank dead last in ypp allowed (8.8) and dead last in ypg allowed (597). Despite the offensive struggles last week, Auburn showed in week 1 that it is capable of scoring (73 vs FCS opponent).

BAYLOR 30 Air Force 13. Air Force has been shockingly bad so far this year. Remember, when they were -0.4 in yards per play vs Merrimack? Well Merrimack was trailing Connecticut 56-7 at halftime last week. The Falcons are 0-2 ATS and have failed to cover both games by an average of 14 ppg. Baylor is 2-0 ATS this season but did benefit from Utah QB Cam Rising getting hurt last week. We bet Baylor.

TCU 31 Ucf 29. Both teams can be sloppy and inconsistent but both have high upside and can win the Big 12. The most trust-worthy facet to us is the UCF ground game which is averaging 419 ypg. It's a loaded RB room led by RJ Harvey. How many guys will TCU commit to the box and can QB KJ Jefferson make them pay? TCU's defense is No. 8 in ypp. This is maybe the best game of the day.

Georgia 34 KENTUCKY 13. What the hell was that performance from Kentucky last week? The Wildcats lost 31-6 to South Carolina as 9.5-point favorites. QB Vandagriff was benched for Gavin Wimsatt. Now they welcome in the No. 1 team in the country that is off a lowly FCS opponent. Prior to last season, UK had played UGA tough losing by 10, 17 and 11. Even though our ratings like UK, we're passing.

Colorado 33 COLORADO STATE 24. It is the same old story for Colorado this year. The Buffs can't run the ball averaging just 38 ypg and can't protect Shedeur Sanders as they allowed 6 sacks last week in the loss to Nebraska. Colorado State is hosting this game for the first time since 1996 so we expect an electric atmosphere. Both teams are 0-2 ATS this year so we'll learn a lot from this data point.

UCLA 25 Indiana 24. Indiana is No. 3 in ypp margin (+5.7), No. 4 in ypg margin (+406) and No. 4 in scoring margin (+49). They scored the most points in school history last week (77-3). UCLA almost lost to Hawaii in their opener. It's no wonder why the Hoosiers find themselves road favorites. However, this is a step up in class for Indiana after playing a bottom 10 FBS team in FIU and a Western Illinois team that has lost 26 straight games. UCLA is off a bye and our power ratings like the Bruins.

TENNESSEE 56 Kent State 9. We're not sure there is a team that has been more impressive than Tennessee so far this season. The Vols are 2-0 straight up winning by 53.5 ppg and 2-0 ATS covering by 30 points per game! Meanwhile, Kent State just lost to FCS St. Francis as a 17.5-point favorite! We prefer the OVER to the side.

HOUSTON 25 Rice 20. Will the real Rice and Houston please stand up? Is Houston the team that got blown out at home vs UNLV in the opener or the team that nearly upset Oklahoma last week? Is Rice as bad as they looked vs Sam Houston State in the opener or the team that covered by 34 points last week. As of now, we're not involved.

Maryland 30 VIRGINIA 28. Two teams with disparate 4Q's last week. Maryland blew a 24-17 lead and lost outright as 8-point home favorites to Michigan State. Meanwhile, Virginia rallied from a 30-17 deficit to beat Wake Forest 31-30 on the road. Statistically, UVA has been better in ypp margin (+1.3 vs +0.5). However, we're passing.

Byu 26 WYOMING 16. BYU is off an upset win as a 12.5-point underdog at SMU last week. Meanwhile, Wyoming is off an upset loss as 7.5-point favorites vs FCS Idaho. Usually, that screams value for Wyoming here but there's not a lot of redeeming qualities for the Pokes. Wyoming is No. 133 in ypp and ypg on offense and their defense has also taken a step back from last season.

FRESNO STATE 36 New Mexico State 16. New Mexico State rebounded from a horrific performance vs SE Missouri State to nearly upset Liberty last week. In fact, the Aggies led the Flames 24-15 in the 4Q before falling 30-24. Meanwhile, Fresno got their first win of the season by beating FCS Sacramento State. We lean OVER here.

CALIFORNIA 33 San Diego State 16. Cal is off the big upset (+12) at Auburn last week where the Bears were +5 in TO's. They're taking on a San Diego State team that was shutout vs Oregon State. Cal is banged up at multiple positions including RB Ott but we're not sure we can fully trust this San Diego State offense yet.

SAN JOSE STATE 32 Kennesaw State 14. San Jose State has been better than expected so far under new coach Ken Niumatalolo. The Spartans got a nice conference upset win over Air Force last week where the market bet them from +6.5 to +2.5. They're taking on a Kennesaw State team that is 0-2 in their first year of FBS play. Kennesaw is No. 131 in ypp margin, No. 130 in ypg margin and No. 125 in scoring margin. We prefer the OVER here.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

Games in Rotation Order
Thursday, September 12th

MIAMI 25 Buffalo 24. Last week the Dolphins rallied from a 10-point halftime deficit to beat Jacksonville by 3 (they were laying 3.5). They did have a 6.2-5.3 yards per play edge and outgained the Jags 400-267. Obviously, the news has centered around WR Tyreek Hill's arrest this week. Meanwhile, Buffalo also won their home opener but failed to cover by a 0.5-point vs Arizona. Buffalo did have a 6.1-4.5 ypp edge in the game. Buffalo has owned this series winning 10 of the last 11. We lean Bills.

Sunday, September 15th

BALTIMORE 26 Las Vegas 16. Both teams coming off losses from last week. The Ravens came up an inch short at KC in a game where they had a 452-353 yard edge. Meanwhile, the Raiders led the Chargers 7-6 at halftime but Jim Harbaugh made appropriate halftime adjustments and outscored the Raiders 16-3 in the second half. The Raiders were -3 in TO's. Jim should give some pointers to brother John.

L.A. Chargers 21 CAROLINA 16. The look-ahead line on this game was LAC -3.5. Obviously, the Chargers won and covered vs the Raiders 22-10 (LAC was +3 in TO's). Meanwhile, the Panthers were crushed 47-10 at New Orleans. The Panthers were -2.6 in yards per play and were outgained by nearly 200 yards. Week 2 is a classic overreaction week. Generally speaking underdogs of more than 4 points off a 35+ point loss have gone 48-18-2 ATS (73%) over the past 20 years in the NFL (per Stuckey of The Action Network). We lean Carolina especially if a +7 were to appear.

DALLAS 26 New Orleans 21. Both teams come in off blowout wins last week. New Orleans beat Carolina 47-10 and had a massive 6.1-3.5 yards per play edge. Dallas upset Cleveland 33-17 as 2-point road underdogs. Prior to their upset loss vs the Packers, the Cowboys had won 11 straight games as a home favorite of -6 or more. Winning is one thing, covering is another and the Cowboys are 45% ATS in this role (home favorite of -6 or more) since 2010.

DETROIT 30 Tampa Bay 24. It was an extremely fortunate cover for Lions backers last week as Detroit won 26-20 in OT over the Rams as 5-point favorites. Now they face another team, they beat at home in the playoffs last year. The Bucs had a big opening week win over Washington 37-20. The early week money has been on the OVER and we agree.

Indianapolis 22 GREEN BAY 20. Obviously, Jordan Love is out for Green Bay and Malik Willis will get the start at QB. The look-ahead line for this game was Green Bay -5 so we've seen a massive line move here. Both teams are 0-1 coming off high-scoring losses. Green Bay had a 7.1-5.5 yards per play edge but blew a lead vs Philadelphia last Friday in Brazil. Meanwhile, Indy had a 7.0-5.5 yards per play edge but lost by 2 at home to Houston (still covered the spread). We think there has been too much of an adjustment in the market for Love's absence.

JACKSONVILLE 23 Cleveland 20. Both teams come off disappointing losses last week. Jacksonville's was disappointing as they blew a 10-point lead at Miami with a ridiculous 4th down play-call blowing up in their face. Meanwhile, Cleveland was non-competitive at home vs Dallas a 2-point favorites. We don't like Deshaun Watson. We think what Cleveland gave up and what they paid Watson will go down as the worst trade in the history of the NFL. For a player that had injury issues and has off-field issues, we don't think there is path forward and they should cut their losses sooner than later. We prefer the OVER here.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

San Francisco 24 MINNESOTA 20. We couldn't be more impressed with the 49ers who despite Christian McCaffrey being a late scratch, beat the Jets 32-19 with a 401-266 yard edge. However, now they're traveling on a short week, playing at 10am PT against a Minnesota team we think is underrated. The Vikings destroyed the Giants last week (we gave out Minnesota to VIP clients). Minnesota had a 6.1-3.5 yards per play edge. We like Minny here to keep it close.

Seattle 21 NEW ENGLAND 17. Obviously, the Patriots wrecked havoc on a ton of teasers and survivor contests last week. They pulled the Week 1 shocker beating Cincinnati 16-10 as 7.5-point underdogs. However, they were +2 in TO's and had a negative ypp margin. Now they face an impressive young Seattle staff that took care of business vs Denver (5.1-3.3 ypp edge). We agree with the Seattle -3 buy on Wednesday.

N.Y. Jets 21 TENNESSEE 19. Tennessee backers deserved better last week. The Titans led 17-3 at halftime. The Titans had a 244-148 yard edge. The Titans had a 4.0-2.8 yards per play edge. Yet, somehow they lost 24-17 as 4-point underdogs at Chicago. Now they're facing a Jets team on the road for the 2nd straight week after losing to San Francisco on MNF. We like Tennessee.

WASHINGTON 23 N.Y. Giants 20. We don't like either team this year and it was a big reason why our biggest bet this off-season was the Eagles to win the NFC East. Both these teams got spanked in Week 1. At least the Commanders' loss came on the road and they had some semblance of an offense (5.3 ypp) while the Giants were crushed at home and were feeble on offense (3.5 ypp). Tough trusting a rookie though in a favorite role though.

L.A. Rams 25 ARIZONA 24. Both teams suffered tough road losses in Week 1. The Cardinals did cover by a 0.5-point in Buffalo but were -1.6 in yards per play margin. Meanwhile, the Rams had a 387-363 yard edge in Detroit but lost by 6 in OT. The Rams have covered their last 9 visits here. They are also covering at a 60% clip after a loss since Sean McVay was hired back in 2017. We like them to win outright.

KANSAS CITY 27 Cincinnati 21. Kansas City has a few extra days prep after surviving a scare vs Baltimore last Thursday. Cincinnati wasn't as fortunate. The Bengals early season struggles continued for another season as they lost outright to the Patriots as 7.5-point favorites. Cincinnati was -2 in TO's but only put up 224 yards of offense. They'll need a lot more here to stay with the Chiefs. We saw a sharp group take Cincinnati on Wednesday but we don't see much value.

DENVER 19 Pittsburgh 18. Pittsburgh is fat and happy off an upset win over Atlanta last week. The Steelers outscored the Falcons 9-0 in the second half and benefited from a +3 TO margin. They were -0.4 in ypp margin. Now they go on the road for a 2nd week in a row. Denver, historically has been tough at home early in the season because teams are not used to the altitude. We like the Broncos outright.

HOUSTON 26 Chicago 20. The Bears had the most misleading win of Week 1 last week. Despite trailing 17-3 at halftime and despite managing just 148 yards of total offense, they somehow won and covered vs Tennessee 24-17. Now they face a Houston team that survived on the road in Indianapolis. In a battle of two young talented QB's and we prefer the one (CJ Stroud) in his second year.

Monday, September 16th

PHILADELPHIA 26 Atlanta 20. Atlanta is off a misleading loss to the Steelers where the Falcons were -3 in TO's and were shut out in the second half. Meanwhile, the Eagles got a comeback win over the Packers in Brazil despite a -1.6 yards per play deficit. Week 2 is a classic overreaction week so we lean with the Falcons here. However, we will wait on a possible "+7" to show in the market.
