For any plumbing inspection requirements, this fee will be \$250.00.

There must be shoring if the ditches are deeper than 3' - if there is no shoring the inspection will fail. The charge for any reinspection will be \$175.00.

There must also be 1 foot of gravel below and 1 foot of gravel over the top.

COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING TO HAVE SHERIDAN'S AUTHORIZED SEWER CONTRACTOR PERFORM WORK AND BILL YOU FOR SERVICES

I, the below signing owner/occupant certify that the information provided on this PUBLIC SEWER PERMIT APPLICATION is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I acknowledge receipt of CHAPTER 8 – DRAINAGE of the MUNICIPAL CODE OF SHERIDAN and agree to abide by such. I agree to pay the fees incurred by the Village within 30 days of being billed for such. I acknowledge that if fees are not paid within 30 days after they are billed, such charges shall be deemed delinquent and shall constitute a lien upon the real estate for which the service or benefit was supplied and may be perfected and enforced against such owner, occupant and against subsequent purchasers, lienholders, mortgagees and other transferees. Should charges become delinquent, a late fee shall be added thereto and collected at the rate of 1% per month of the delinquent amount. Should any delinquency continue for 60 days, the Village may at their option terminate sewer service.

TO BE COMPLETED BY LICENSED PLUMBER OF YOUR CHOOSING

I, a plumber licensed by the state of Illinois, certify that I have received a copy of CHAPTER 8 – DRAINAGE of the MUNICIPAL CODE OF SHERIDAN and agree to abide by such including without limit the following provisions:

-Procure public liability insurance in an amount not less than \$100,000 for injuries, including accidental death, to any one person and subject to the same limit for each person in an amount not less than \$300,000 on account of one accident, and property damage insurance in an amount not less than \$100,000.00. The Village of Sheridan shall be named as an additional insured party (not merely a certificate holder). Proof of insurance shall be filed with Village prior to the commencement of any work.

-Procure a performance bond with corporate surety thereon in the sum of the greater of \$1,000 or 100% of the estimated cost of the work to be done. Such performance bond shall be approved by the Village Attorney, conditioned upon the applicant indemnifying, saving harmless and agreeing to pay for the costs of defense incurred by the Village, for all damage to underground utilities, or to the water lines from any failure to restore any road, ditch, pavement or portion thereof damaged during the construction of the sewer connection, or the sewer extension to the condition existing at the commencement of construction.

-File with the Village Plumber anticipated repair plans, specifications, or other information reasonably required by the Village Plumber or Village Engineer.

-Allow inspections and pay inspection fees as required by the Village Plumbing Inspector.

-Work shall comply with the building codes as established by the “CABO ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLING CODE” and the procedures set forth in that publication entitled *Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Main Construction in Illinois*, published by the Standard Specifications Committee of the Illinois Society of Professional Engineers, and other similar organizations, third edition.

-All excavations required for sewer work shall be open trench work unless otherwise approved by the Village. No backfill shall be placed until the work has been inspected by the Plumbing Inspector.

-All excavations shall be adequately guarded with barricades and lights so as to protect the public from hazard. Streets, sidewalks, parkways and other public property disturbed in the course of the work shall be restored in a manner satisfactory to the Village.
