- Excessive schooling, inhumane treatment or unacceptable behavior by participants will be subject to review by review by show committee and may result in dismissal from the show grounds.
- Horses that are out of control will be excused from the arena.
- No stallions allowed in the show arena.
- All shows are subject to weather permitting.
