
DESCRIPTION: This refinished Shakespeare is an exceptionally accurate shooting bow, but it has a few cosmetic flaws. The bow itself is structurally sound. It is a great looking and performing recurve. Bubinga riser with a satin finish. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No drilled holes; No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches, dings and nicks here and there. Decals are a reproduction. This bow would normally be listed in the \$200 range, but is being discounted due to the cosmetic flaws.

The **flaws include:** Some discoloration of the limbs; the back and face overlays on the riser had some minor separation which was filled and touched up; a couple of filled nicks in the overlay (see pics on the last 3 pages).
