Plant Operators Report:

- Monthly flow meter report.
- Five ballast replacements for UV system completed.
- RAM's service report dated 9/26/2014- impellers on both pumps are bad and should be replaced. Estimated cost for replacement \$5,600.00. One new spare at the plant, clogging and debris gathering in the impellers, one current impeller can be machined and used as a emergency spare.
- The letter concerning the sludge press that was reviewed by the CMSA board members.
 - Influent and effluent PH's are low, still within allowances.
 - O Concerns of non-ventilation during the winter months, when no plant door can be opened for ventilation.
 - The amount of the mist in the air, pathogens in the air leading to low air quality, health issues.
 - High maintenance to keep it clean, slippery floor surfaces that may lead to slip and fall injuries.
 - Typical life expectancy of the current sludge press is 20 years; the belt press is currently 10 years old.
 - O Better technologies are available: funds should be budgeted and set aside for the replacement of the belt press. 2014 prices for a new belt press would range from \$350 to \$450 thousand.
 - o Parts are still available to complete repairs on current belt press.
 - Safety equipment to be utilized.
- The EAD's engineers are to evaluate the problems with the sludge press and proposed solutions for the issues discussed.
- Discussion with Lilly Borough concerning the sludge press.
- Computer upgrade at the WWTP, tower has been replaced with updated programs.
