



We drove by Station Street Grill, or should I


say the Muslim Community Centre


didn't eat and drink enough for them. It served our purposes for awhile - until they asked us to move on.

Assembly Plant Update with Kai Spande

- $_{\odot}$ Assembly Plant opened May25th, a slow, steady start to ensure safety & quality; and allow staff to regain muscle memory after 6 weeks off; only 15 cars produced on May 26th
- o Covid-19 protocols in place at entry & exit of Plant; all workers wear masks
- Shipping of new cars will commence approx. 2 weeks following assembly
- o Plant Manager could not say when all tours will start again due to the pandemic
- o No parts or supplies shortages; most suppliers have been working throughout.

Corvette Racing Update with Doug Fehan

- o Team is ready for reopening of the season, July 4 at Daytona
- o Full crew will be at work June 1st to prep the cars for the race
- A new BOP will be in place for Daytona; but it's a continuous process, never a 'final' BOP
- o Testing was cancelled during the Covid, no testing possible prior to July 4 race
- He sees improvement in the core group of competitors, with Porsche the most improved; Ferrari is always a challenge; all three competitors are able to win.
- o Highest competition in racing is in IMSA.
- Corvette Racing fans are the most educated and passionate at the track!

- The NCM will reopen to the public on June 8th
- Marshall Performance Gallery and the Entombed Corvette exhibit are officially open;
 both well worth a visit!
- Two new colours for the 2021 C8 Corvettes: Silver Flare Metallic (replacing Blade Silver) and Red Mist Tint Coat Metallic (replacing Long Beach Red)
- No price increase for 2021
- o 20,181 orders are in the system for 2020 C8 Corvettes.

Corvette Racing Crew Chief Dan Binks Retires



After nearly 40 years in motor racing, Corvette Racing's Crew Chief Dan Binks has announced his retirement. A leader on pit row and in the garage for the Corvette Racing team since 2002, Dan has been a part of winning racing teams since the early 1980s. Dan Binks is popular among Corvette fans and a friend to many in the Corvette Racing family. Dan told us he likes coming to CTMP so he could attend the Blackstock Tractor Pull! Dan did a Q&A session at the Corvette Corral in July, 2011 sharing interesting bits of team lore. We will

miss seeing Dan, his wife and family at the track; they are very approachable people. Most years they drove to CTMP in their motorhome either before or after the Watkins Glen race, depending on the schedule, and parked at the track along with other campers.

During the August 26, 2009 Race Fest in downtown Toronto, the only parking space available for the CR haulers (and the race cars) was inside the Skydome. At the conclusion of Race Fest, the familiar yellow No. 3 Corvette Racing car needed to be returned to the Skydome. Dan Binks drove the No. 3 along King Street, with heads turning to see what the loud car was. He stopped for a red light and what should pull up beside him, but a Toronto Police cruiser. Uh-oh, thought Dan. He turned off the ignition, looked over at the cop & nodded; the cop returned his nod and at the green light, Dan started up the Corvette and slowly continued along King Street. King Street was never louder than that afternoon! Dan's replacement has not yet been announced.
