



OWNER/BREEDER/EXHIBITOR AWARD:

The goal of the awards program is to recognize the accomplishments of the grassroots equestrians. The owner-breed is a significant contributor to the growth of the industry and the breed registry success, worthy of recognition. Those eligible must be the individual who shows as the breeder, owner and exhibitor on the registration papers. This could include immediate family members.

Definitions:

Owner: An owner is “the last person named on the Certificate of Registration issued by the PtHA”

Breeder: “the owner of the dam at the time of service unless the dam was under a lease at the time of breeding and written notice of the lease is on file with the PtHA at the time of registration. In that case, the lessee is the breeder of the foal”

Exhibitor: An exhibitor is the individual who shows the horse as the handler and/or rider

Owner/Breeder/Exhibitor – qualification is determined by, PtHA rules on ‘immediate family members’

- Must be current paid members of the Iowa Pinto Horse Association.
- Must provide original registration paper for the office to make a copy to show Owner/Breeder qualifications.
- Points from any division or class sponsored by Iowa Pinto will count towards the award. NSBA, ABO and 4-H/FFA classes included.
- Award will be given to horse/rider combo that accumulates the most total points in a given year at Iowa Pinto shows.

A nomination fee of \$10.00 will be required with the appropriate paperwork. Points do not begin to count until the nomination fee is paid.
