REPORT ON KEN'S LAKE: The clay plug in the large leak is complete. Blanket will be Ken's laid above the clay. Four sink holes were found on the south side of reservoir. The Lake Report leaks are not big and are the type where fabric will need to be installed.

September Financial Report: Marsha reported that the District has received 72% Financial of yearly revenues and spent 78%. Pumping costs for irrigation are high due to Report - Sej pumping this season, with final bills not yet received.

ITEMS FROM BOARD MEMBERS: James Walker noted that Sheley Tunnel flows on the Sheley lake report were estimated lower than the period preceding the estimation. Dale said Tunnel Flows an estimate was necessary during the time frame the solar panels were stolen. The estimate was based on the average flow the day before and day following the estimated period.

LEASE MOAB IRRIGATION WATER: Last year the District leased approximately 80 Lease Moab shares of water from Moab Irrigation Stockholders for one year. Dale asked if the Irrigation District should pursue leasing this water again, but on a long term basis. The District Water would need to sell the water to justify the cost of leasing. Bobbie motioned to lease but not sell the water to new connections. Bill seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLANNING: Impact fees are no longer valid as of July 1, 1997. Capital The next step would be to put in a capital improvement plan and identify facilities and Improvement the time frame for completion of them. Dale requested the Board allocate \$2,500 in Planning the budget for 1997 to pay Hofman Planning Associates to complete a capital improvement plan, Motioned: Bill Seconded: Bobbie MOTION CARRIED

NED DALTON'S BOARD TERM: Ned's term expired in September. The District Ned Dalton' advertised the position and only received one letter in response. That letter was from Board Term Ned Dalton. This position is appointed by the Governor's office with Senate approval and requires three applicants. Gary suggested sending a letter to Grand and San Juan County to support Ned's nomination. The District will send a letter to the Counties and Dale will attend their meetings and ask for support.
