Green Church Suggestion: Use block soap. This helps reduce plastic packaging significantly. It will cost you more but lasts close to 6 months, so you're saving!



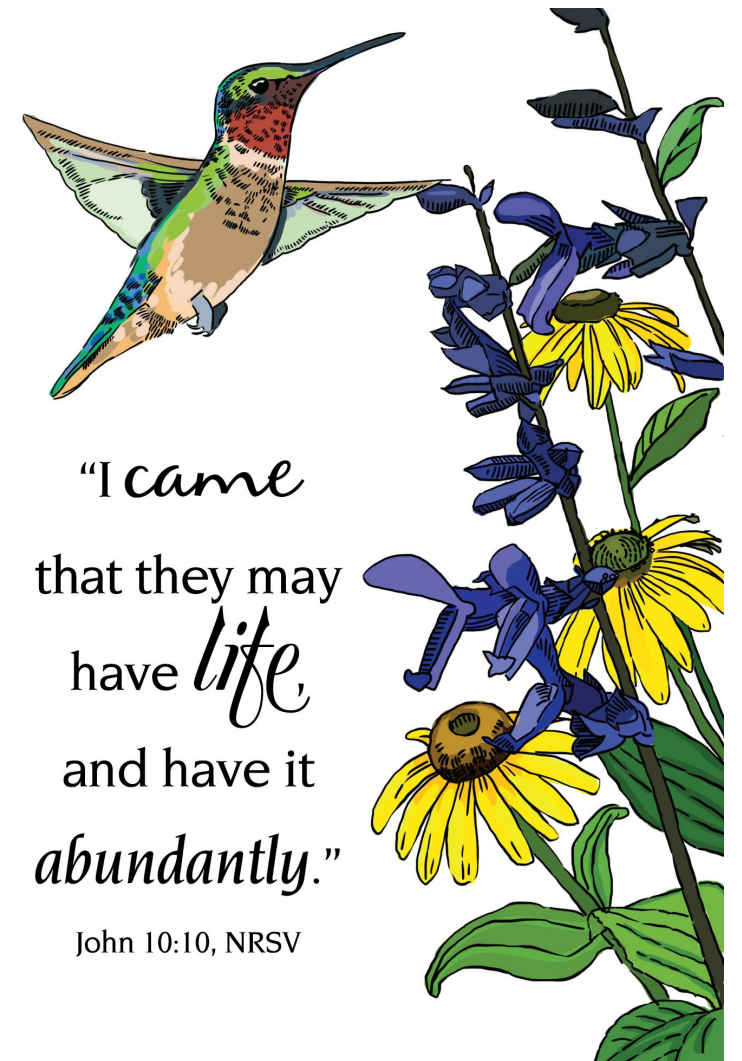
