

# **EDITH GOODMAN AWARD**

## **Composition of the Committee**

The Award Committee shall be made up of a sitting President or Presidents; Membership Vice President, a member cognizant of members' abilities and performance, plus a former recipient, where applicable.

## **Final Vote**

The committee shall submit at least written names to their Board and a secret vote shall be made and given to a designated committee member who will tally the votes. In the event of a tie, the President or Presidents should make the choice from the list of names submitted.

The name of the recipient should be given to Steve Goodman, no later than March 1, so that he can have the recipient's name engraved on the Award. Mr. Goodman should also be advised of the Installation date so that he, or someone he designates in his place, will be available for the presentation.

## **Possession of the Award**

After presentation of the Award, the Award itself should be held by the recipient for a period of one year and then be returned to Steve Goodman. The recipient will be given a framed certificate marking the event.

## **Criteria**

Any bona fide member, other than a sitting President, is eligible. The member need not be a member of long standing.

The awardee should:

1. Be dedicated to NCJW
2. Personify the goals of NCJW
3. Be inspirational
4. Be positive
5. Be conspicuous in not only discharging any office or duties placed upon her, but be seen to enhance any role she plays.
