

CASHA Academy High Point Year End Awards Information

Qualifying Shows:

- Colorado Classic Horse Show
- Almost Summer Horse Show
- Denver Queen City Horse Show
- Any other horse show which applies for and is granted approval by CASHA during the show season

General Rules for Year End Awards:

- Points follow riders only, regardless of horse that is ridden
- Riders only must be members in good standing of CASHA (with any type of membership)
- Points count only for those shows in which the rider is a member in good standing of CASHA
- Only one horse is required to fill a class to make it official

Point System for Year End Awards:

1 st	6	12
2 nd	5	10
3 rd	4	8
4 th	3	6
5 th	2	4
6 th	1	2

A Champion year end award will be given in the following academy categories:

- Equitation English/Western Walk, Trot (Jog), Canter (Lope)
- Equitation English/Western Walk and Trot (Jog)
- Pleasure English/Western Walk, Trot (Jog), Canter (Lope)
- Pleasure English/Western Walk and Trot (Jog)
- Equitation on the Line English/Western Walk and Trot (Jog)

Note: Classes that count toward year end award points will be determined by the CASHA board at their sole discretion and may vary from show to show.
