

**MINUTES**  
**SUMMERFIELD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION**  
**March 11, 2019**

The regular March meeting of the Summerfield Township Planning Commission was called to order on March 11, 2019, by Chairperson Amy Reiter at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Amy Reiter, David G. Grude, Joe Stanger and Dick Koraleski were present. Gary Missler was absent but excused.

AGENDA: Upon motion of Joe Stanger, seconded by Dick Koraleski and by unanimous approval, the Agenda as amended was approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 11, 2019, REGULAR MEETING: Upon motion of Amy Reiter, seconded by Dick Koraleski, and by unanimous approval, the minutes from the regular meeting on February 11, 2019, were approved.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

OLD BUSINESS: Mighty Auto Parts came before the Planning Commission with an amended site plan for car parts that meet the zoning requirements of the Township. Upon motion of Amy Reiter, a second by David Grude and unanimous decision, the Planning Commission approved a recommendation to the Board to approve the amended site plan.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Hidden Lake Campground site plan review - Dean Lowrie, owner of Hidden Lake Campground, presented a site plan for the construction of a new swimming pool. Having been satisfied that all provisions of the zoning ordinance have been met, Amy Reiter recommended approval by the Board, second by Dick Koraleski and unanimous consent, the Planning Commission recommended Board approval.

b. Safe Source Meds - Safe Source Meds LLC gave a presentation to the Planning Commission hoping to convince the Planning Commission to recommend that Summerfield Township change its ordinance and “opt in” to allowing medical marijuana businesses in the Township. A slide presentation along with prepared material was presented and questions were answered. It was noted by Chairperson Amy Reiter that the Planning Commission was not in a position to vote on the matter as the Board had not requested that the Planning Commission revisit the Township’s ordinance “opting out”.
