This past week we transitioned from the season of Easter, the festival of the Day of Pentecost, and the commemoration of The Holy Trinity, into what is often referred to in the church as ordinary time. Throughout this long season, we use the color green in our worship space to reflect the greening action of the Holy Spirit; that is, the power to create vitality, fecundity, lushness and growth in the lives of individuals and the church.

We humans tend to view anything described as "ordinary" as "not special", but considerthe patterns and pathways of your life, or, perhaps, a smaller sample of your life such as a year.
