

An Open Door Leads the Way

*“...I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me”
(Galatians 2:20).*

The Lord speaks to each us in ways we understand. In my quiet time, I saw the image of a door with the word “Faith” written across it. I somehow knew I was being given a choice. I could open the door or leave it close. As I pondered the door, I heard, “Faith is an open door through which the Lord comes.”
