Safe digging is no accident! If you are installing a fence or deck, or digging for a mailbox post, patio or other excavation project, it is important to "Know What's Below". Dial 8-1-1 or 1-800-242-1776 a minimum of three (3) days before you dig. The utility companies do not want an accident, either. The best way to learn where underground utility lines are located is to call before you dig. If you plan to disturb the earth with powered equipment, you are required by Pennsylvania law to notify the underground utility companies of your intent to do so. Notification occurs by calling 8-1-1 or 1-800-242-1776, 24 hours a day, every day of the year.
