

DESIGN OF FACILITY

Providing a caring professional staff is a primary concern at Schulenburg Regency, but we also understand the importance of providing a facility that meets the needs of our residents and gives them a comfortable “at home” feeling. We have taken considerable care to ensure that Schulenburg Regency does exactly that.

The facility is made up of five wings, one of which is designed for the more confused resident.

Each wing includes a large dayroom that gives residents an opportunity to enjoy time away from their individual rooms, visiting with other residents or family members. The day rooms look out onto beautifully landscaped courtyards, providing residents with an excellent way to enjoy the changing of the seasons. The day rooms can also be reserved by families so that residents can enjoy parties, reunions, or other events that cannot be handled in the residents' rooms. The interior of the center has been coordinated especially for senior citizens, using colors and furnishings that enhance a warm, secure feeling. Much of the facility has been carpeted to allow for a quiet, glare-free environment. Large windows used throughout the center allow for natural lighting and bring the outdoors inside for residents who may not be able to go out frequently.

In addition, Schulenburg Regency is equipped with a high tech Wander Guard security system that alerts the staff to residents who pass through doors leading to unsecured areas. This allows the residents a great deal of freedom while ensuring their safety.

ACTIVITIES

We strive to ensure that Schulenburg Regency residents are happy by helping them fulfill the need that each of us has to feel useful and productive. Our Activity Program plays a major role in this effort because it helps our residents continue to contribute to their communities and to accomplish goals.
