Mildred Ethel Zakay, 76 of Sand Point, passed away Monday, Nov. 21 at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit.

She was born June 21, 1918 in Detroit, daughter of the late William and Clara (Teechke) Wilkewitz. She was united in marriage to Rudolph Zakay on May 21, 1938 in Detroit.
