Being baptized, immersed in water for the forgiveness of our sins (*Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 1 Peter 3:21*)


Once we have become a Christian, then we must **live faithfully until death** (*1 John 1:7; Revelation 2:10*)



Our Worship Service

We have a worship service each Sunday morning. This service is patterned after the things the churches in the New Testament did during their assemblies. Our worship service includes the following activities:

Singing We sing "a capella", without the use of any musical instruments. (*Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16*)

Praying Our men lead the church in prayers to God. (*Acts 2:42; 1 Timothy 2:1*)

Communion We partake of the communion, or Lord's Supper, every Sunday. (*Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11: 18-22*)

Giving We take up a monetary collection each Sunday to fund the work of the church. (*Acts 2:45, 4:32-35; 1 Corinthians 16:1*)

Teaching We hear a lesson from God's word. (*Acts 2:42; 1 Corinthians 14:26*)

Bible Classes

We have Bible classes on Sunday morning and on Wednesday evening. During these classes we study the Bible to further our knowledge and understanding of God's word (*2 Timothy 2:15*). Classes are divided into age groups for both adults and children.

Our Core Beliefs

God exists. He created all things and desires that all mankind be saved. (*Genesis 1:1, John 1:1-2, 2 Peter 3:9*)

The Bible is an accurate account of God's word that he revealed to mankind. (*1 Corinthians 2:11-13, 2 Peter 1:20-21*)

Jesus is the Son of God. He lived as a man, died on the cross and was raised from the dead. (*John 1: 32-34, Luke 3:21-22, John 1:14, 1 Corinthians 15: 3-4*)

Jesus' death provides the only means for the forgiveness of our sins and our salvation. (*Hebrews 10:10-14*)

Jesus' resurrection gives us the hope of living eternally with God in Heaven. (*1 Corinthians 15: 20-22; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18*)

Jesus established his church. He is the head of the church and the church is his body. (*Matthew 16:18, Ephesians 1:22-23*)

Salvation is available to all. It requires both God's grace and our obedience to God's word. (*Acts 10; 34-35, Mark 16:16, Ephesians 2: 8-10, Matthew 7:21, James 2:24*)
