Without further adieu, here's a run down of what happened last week in the world of CFB.

Despite playing without 20 players including 8 starters, Arkansas St (+14.5, +450 on the ML) beat Kansas State outright 35-31 last Saturday. WR Jonathan Adams (pictured above) had 3 receiving TD's including the game-winner with just :38 left.

#### ATS Notables

First-year head coaches are now 2-8 ATS this season.  
Teams with 5 or more spring practices than their opponents and both teams are playing their first game are 6-2 ATS.  
Overall teams with more spring practice time are 10-6 ATS.  
Sun Belt teams are 7-4 ATS this year but with a cover margin of 8.6 ppg.  
Big 12 teams are 2-5 ATS this year but are failing to cover by 12.9 ppg.

#### Misleading Finals

**North Carolina** (-24) outscored Syracuse 21-0 in the 4Q to get the cover in a 31-6 win. The Tar Heels were "steamed" all week as they opened -19.5.

**Appalachian St** (-16.5) dominated Charlotte more than the 35-20 final with 29-16 first down and 512-286 yard edges including 308-146 on the ground.

**Georgia Tech** (+13) should have won by more than the 16-13 final as they had a 438-307 yard edge including 161-109 on the ground. Georgia Tech threw an INT from the FSU 34-yard line, had a 22-yard FG blocked, threw an INT from the FSU 15-yard line, missed a 38-yard FG and missed an extra point.

**Kansas** (-5.5) actually had 23-19 first down and 367-318 yard edges but were -3 in TO's. The Jayhawks had those 3 TO's and a missed FG in the first half and saw Coastal Carolina jump out to a 28-0 lead.

**Louisville** (-13) dominated Western Kentucky more than the 35-21 final with 22-12 first down and 487-248 yard edges. WKU got a 1-play 1-yard TD "drive" after a blocked punt and another TD on a 2-play 4-yard drive after another blocked punt. Louisville led 28-7 at halftime and had a 337-120 yard edge at the break.

**Iowa St** (-13) had 18-14 first down and 303-272 yard edges but were -2 in TO's in a 31-14 upset loss to UL-Lafayette. The Ragin' Cajuns got a 95-yard kick return TD, a 78-yard passing TD, a 83-yard punt return TD and scored a TD with :10 left.

#### Bad Beats

**The OVER in the Houston Baptist/Texas Tech game** was steamed up nearly 10 points (from 71 to 80) in most shops on Saturday. The two teams combined for 1,224 yards but "only" 68 points. Houston Baptist was intercepted at the Texas Tech 1-yard line on first and goal, stopped on downs on 4th and goal at the 1-yard line and came up short on a 2-point conversion late in the 4Q. Texas Tech was also stopped on downs at the Houston Baptist 4-yard line. Early bettors on the OVER had to be kicking themselves. Note that had Houston Baptist pulled the outright upset, it would've been the 3rd largest in College Football history.

**Pitt** (-30) backers were dealt a really bad beat last Saturday due to a technicality. Even though Pitt easily covered in a 55-0 win over Austin Peay, there was no action on this game due to the second half consisting of 10 minute quarters. Per most shops, you must play at least 55 minutes in order for their to be action.

Late to the party **Oklahoma** (-48.5) backers came up a half-point short in the Sooners 48-0 win over Missouri St. OU scored on their first 7 possessions, led 41-0 at halftime but put the offense away in the second half. OU finished the game on the 2-yard line of Missouri St. Early backers of Oklahoma (Sooners opened up -40.5) were rewarded with a win.

#### Injuries/COVID Cases

**Arkansas St** played without 20 players including 8 starters but still pulled the outright upset over Kansas St. The line moved from Kansas St -10 to -14.5 and ended up being wrong.

**Georgia Southern** was missing 33 players including 10 projected starters. VIP customers got an alert one hour before kickoff to bet Campbell +29 and the Camels nearly won outright in a 27-26 loss.

**Kansas**, had nearly 40 players that did not dress for undisclosed reasons. Starting WR Stephon Robinson Jr. and top TE Jack Luavasa were among them.

Seven **Pittsburgh** players were held out of the game due to COVID-19 protocol including 4 starters. All are expected back this week.

**Texas St** QB Brady McBride was out with COVID.

**West Virginia** overcame the suspension of 11 players for reasons that were undisclosed and not related to the coronavirus pandemic. Ten of those players were on offense, including starters at wide receiver and on the offensive line.

#### Recapping Week Two Best Bets

Coming off our worst season in 5 years, the pressure was really on for us to perform this season. With all the uncertainty of a football season because of COVID, we kept our noses to the grindstone and put more time in than any off-season. Typically even in our best seasons, we have gotten off to slow starts but that has not been the case this season. We've given out six selections so far. We are a perfect 6-0! We have given out 6 underdogs and 4 of those dogs have won outright including Georgia Tech (+12.5) over Florida St, Arizona (+7) over San Francisco, Coastal Carolina (+7) over Kansas and the L.A. Rams (+3) over Dallas last weekend. We are fully aware that sports gambling is a marathon, not a sprint so we're going to keep our heads down and continue to grind. Thanks for being with us so far!

## Week 3 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past three seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 302-252-12 (55%) clip. Last week's plays went 4-2 and now the record for this year is 4-3. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Clemson -44**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

## CFB ATS Trends for Week 3

- UL-Lafayette is 19-10 ATS under head coach Billy Napier with an average cover of 6.2 ppg. They've exceeded expectations by a combined 179.5 points. This week ULL is a 17-point favorite at Georgia St.
- Excluding bowl games, UCF has been a favorite in 35 straight regular season games including this week (-7.5) at Georgia Tech.
- Boston College is 13-4-2 ATS as a road underdog with an average cover of 5.2 ppg. This week the Eagles are 6-point dogs at Duke.
- Liberty head coach Hugh Freeze is 55-33-1 ATS (62.5%) in all games in his coach career. This week Liberty is a 14-point underdog at WKU.
- Texas St has not been a favorite on the road since 2014. They are just 3-27 straight up on the road the last 5 years but find themselves a 6-point favorite at ULM.
- North Texas is just 4-15 ATS in their last 19 games and are 2-TD underdogs at home to SMU this week.
- Since 2003, Navy is 32-14-1 ATS (70%) as a road underdog with an average cover of 6 ppg. That's the best mark of any team in the country. This week they are 7-point dogs at Tulane.
- Middle Tennessee has stark home/away splits the last 6 years going 26-9 SU (59% ATS) at home vs going 14-29 SU (45% ATS) away from home.
- Tulsa is on a 18-9-1 ATS run as a road underdog with an average cover of 3 ppg. This week the Golden Hurricane are 23-point dogs at Oklahoma St.
- Oklahoma St is on a 13-1 ATS run in their last 14 non-conference games with an average cover of 10.5 ppg.

Remember typical Saturday cards feature 50-plus games in normal seasons. With only 20 or so games and much uncertainty, we have limited plays so far.

### Games in Rotation Order

Friday, September 18th

**COASTAL CAROLINA 38 Campbell 14.** Coastal comes in fresh off another outright upset win over Kansas where we cashed on these pages. Kansas actually had 23-19 first down and 367-318 yard edges but were -3 in TO's. Coastal Carolina QB Grayson McCall was 11 of 18 for 133 yards and 3 TD's while also adding 73 rushing yards and 2 TD's. The Chanticleers had three sacks and 10 TFL's. They're taking on a Campbell team that nearly pulled a shocker last Saturday as 4-TD underdogs in their 27-26 loss to a short-handed Georgia Southern team. Campbell scored a TD with :15 left but their 2-point conversion came up short. They do have a quality QB in Hajji-Malik Williams who was 17 of 27 for 237 yards and 2 TD's while adding 73 rushing yards and a TD. Our power ratings have this one close to the current line but expect Coastal to be excited for an ESPN audience. Weather could be a factor.

Saturday, September 19th

**UL-Lafayette 35 GEORGIA ST 20.** UL-Lafayette comes in off the 31-14 upset win at Iowa State last week as 13-point underdogs. It was their first win in school history over a Top 25 opponent on the road as they were 0-26. It was a misleading final as Iowa St had 18-14 first down and 303-272 yard edges but were -2 in TO's. UL-Lafayette got a 95-yard kick return TD, a 78-yard pass TD, a 83-yard punt return TD and scored a TD with :10 left. The Ragin' Cajuns were able to knock off the Cyclones despite two missed field goals by transfer kicker Nate Snyder and a struggling ground game. ULL averaged 6.3 yards per rush last season but Iowa St limited the Ragin' Cajuns to 2.7 ypc on 22 attempts through the first 3Q's. That run game will have more success here vs a suspect Georgia St run defense that allowed 218 rush ypg (5.4 ypc) last season. Cornelious Brown will get the start for Georgia St at QB. We lean with the home dog here as we don't mind fading a team off a big upset and are ranked for the first time in both polls in school history. Also lean UNDER.

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN 27 Florida Atlantic 26.** As we're typing this up on Tuesday evening, FAU just announced they had to cancel practice on Tuesday due to positive COVID-19 cases. The line was FAU -5.5 and crashed down to -2.5. We were already looking to back a Georgia Southern team that had its own COVID problems last week in a 27-26 win over Campbell as 4-TD favorites. Georgia Southern had a 20-17 first down edge but Campbell a 369-346 total yard edge. GS did have a 284-132 rushing yard edge as QB Shai Werts ran for 155 yards. Considering they almost lost outright, the game tape didn't look that bad for GS. On the other side, FAU is one of the least experienced teams in the country. The Owls were only expected to return 9 starters and lost 4 more projected starters late in the summer including QB Chris Robison. They have a new coach in Willie Taggart and new schemes. Georgia Southern has a game under belt advantage and we'll call for the win.

**NC STATE 27 Wake Forest 26.** Wake comes in off a 37-13 cover vs Clemson as 34.5-point underdogs. Clemson had 27-15 first down and 561-330 yard edges including 185-37 on the ground and led 27-0 at halftime. WF QB Sam Hartman was 11 of 21 for 182 yards before being leaving in the second half to injury (could have returned). Wake's reliable kicker missed two FG's in the game. The Demon Deacons really struggled with tackling. Clawson didn't begin full-contact practices until about three weeks ago because he didn't feel good about risking players' health until he was sure there'd be a season. They should be better in that department for this game. Meanwhile, NC State has been dealing with limited practice time due to COVID stoppages. Wake has won and covered vs NC State each of the last 3 years and while NC State is improved, we lean Wake.

**Central Florida 32 GEORGIA TECH 25.** Last week we easily cashed on these pages with Georgia Tech as the Yellow Jackets beat Florida St outright as 13-point underdogs. GT should have won by more as they had a 438-307 yard edge including 161-109 on the ground. GT threw an INT from the FSU 34-yard line, had a 22-yard FG blocked, threw an INT from the FSU 15-yard line, had another 38-yard FG blocked and they missed an extra point. GT true freshman QB Jeff Sims was 24 of 35 for 277 yards (1-2 ratio), and led the Jackets with 64 rushing yards. "I'm just so proud of the men that are in this organization," head coach Geoff Collins said. "Poured their hearts out." Now they face a UCF team that we think is the best Group of 5 team in the country this year (No. 13 in our current power ratings). However, the Knights did see several players opt out in the summer. We want to play on both teams this year and this line is close to our power rating (see page 2) so we are passing on the side but do lean UNDER.

**NORTH CAROLINA 45 Charlotte 14.** First meeting between two in-state foes. Both teams got covers last week but both weren't overly impressive. Charlotte lost 35-20 (+16.5) but Appalachian St dominated more than the final with 29-16 first down and 512-286 yard edges including 308-146 on the ground. Charlotte QB Chris Reynolds was just 11 of 30 for 140 yards and a 0-2 ratio and breaking news on Tuesday is that he will miss this game due to an upper body injury. Dom Shoffner, a JUCO transfer will get the start. The line was North Carolina -27.5 and it appropriately jumped a couple of points. Meanwhile, the Tar Heels had 23-15 first down and 463-202 yard edges but had to outscore Syracuse 21-0 in the 4Q to get the cover. NC QB Sam Howell was 25 of 34 for 295 yards and a 1-2 ratio. The 202 yards were the fewest allowed by UNC against an ACC opponents since giving up 198 to Boston College in 2009. Don't see much value here even with Charlotte's QB out. North Carolina has a bye on deck so there shouldn't be a look-ahead. Small lean UNDER.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**DUKE 29 BOSTON COLLEGE 23.** Last week Duke had a solid showing in a 27-13 (+21.5) loss at Notre Dame. ND had 24-18 first down and 441-332 yard edges including 178-73 on the ground. The Blue Devils, who had 246 yards at halftime, had just 82 after halftime. Chase Brice was 20 of 37 for 259 yards in his debut for Duke. The Blue Devils will have a game under their belt advantage here vs a Boston College team that has a brand new head coach in Jeff Hafley and a brand new QB in ND transfer Phil Jurkovec. After we were impressed last week, we thought we would be betting Duke in this game, but the market is all over this one. Pass.

**LOUISVILLE 31 Miami, FL 30.** This is the best game in the first 3 weeks of the CFB season (until the SEC starts next week). Both teams come off comfortable wins over arguably the two best teams in CUSA. Miami has a couple extra days to prep after the Canes controlled matters vs UAB with 25-14 first down and 495-285 yard edges including 337-80 on the ground. New Miami QB D'Eriq King was 16 of 24 for 144 yards and a 1-0 ratio while also rushing for 83 yards and a TD. Cam'Ron Harris ran for 134 yards and 2 TD's. On the other side, Louisville dominated WKU more than the 35-21 final with 22-12 first down and 487-248 yard edges. WKU got a 1-play 1-yard TD "drive" after a blocked punt and another TD on a 2-play 4-yard drive after another blocked punt. Louisville led 28-7 at halftime and had a 337-120 yard edge at the break. Louisville QB Micale Cunningham was 19 of 34 for 343 yards and 3 TD's. All the early money has come in on Louisville and the OVER. We expect a great game but don't see a lot of value from a betting aspect. Note Louisville does have revenge for an embarrassing 52-27 loss to Miami last year.

**PITTSBURGH 34 Syracuse 14.** Clearly a game where you have one team where the Wise Guys seem to like this year (Pitt) vs another that they clearly don't (Syracuse). It's also a horrible match-up for a Syracuse offensive line that struggled vs North Carolina last week in a 31-6 loss and now face one of the better defensive lines in the country. Last week QB Tommy DeVito was just 13 of 31 for 112 yards. On the bright side, their move to a 3-3-5 scheme under new DC Tony White did have some good moments. On the other side, Pitt crushed Austin Peay 55-0 as 30-point favorites. However, there was no action on the game due to the second half consisting of 10 minute quarters. Per most sportsbooks, you must play at least 55 minutes in order for there to be action. Pitt had 20-7 first down and 456-137 yard edges including 147-1 on the ground. Pitt was +3 in TO's and led 42-0 at halftime. Seven Panthers players were held out of the game due to COVID-19 protocol including 4 starters. All are expected back this week. Lean UNDER.

**Appalachian St 32 Marshall 26.** This game has been moved to the 3:30pm ET CBS window and one of the positives of the season so far as been the added attention to some Group of 5 programs. You have two quality ones here. First, Marshall comes in off a bye after destroying Eastern Kentucky 59-0. Marshall dominated with 34-7 first down and 627-166 yard edges including 282-86 on the ground. QB Grant Wells was 16 of 23 for 307 yards and 4 TD's and looked like the best Marshall QB since Rakeem Cato (2014). On the other side, Appalachian St dominated Charlotte more than the 35-20 final with 29-16 first down and 512-286 yard edges including 308-146 on the ground. App St had two rushers top 100 yards in Marcus Williams (117) and Cameron Peoples (102). Do note the Herd a ZERO spring practices and basically a scrimmage game vs an average FCS team at best while App St had 11 spring practices and beat up a bowl team from last year. Lean on the road team.

**WESTERN KENTUCKY 34 Liberty 21.** WKU has a game under their belt advantage here. Last week, the Hilltoppers lost 35-21 at Louisville. However, Louisville dominated more than the final with 22-12 first down and 487-248 yard edges. WKU got a 1-play 1-yard TD "drive" after a blocked punt and another TD on a 2-play 4-yard drive after another blocked punt. Louisville led 28-7 at halftime and had a 337-120 yard edge at the break. WKU QB Tyrell Pigrome was 10 of 23 for 129 yards and a TD but ran for 68 yards. Meanwhile, Liberty has to replace their all-time leading passer at QB in Stephen Calvert and their all-time leading WR in Antonio Gandy-Golden. They will likely go to Auburn transfer Malik Willis at QB. Even with the GUB advantage and the returning experience edge, we don't see too much value here. We do lean OVER.

**1★ SOUTHERN MISS 34 Louisiana Tech 24.** Southern Miss had a horrific opener where they lost 32-21 outright to South Alabama as 12.5-point favorites. The Golden Eagles saw head coach Jay Hopson resign a couple days after and they will have an interim coach in Scott Walden here. Walden a 30-year-old receivers coach, was the youngest head coach in the NCAA in 2016 when he led Division III East Texas Baptist University to a 7-3 record scoring 49.9 points per game and averaging 568.2 yards per game. "We're going to attack people." Walden said of his philosophy. "We're going to put up points. We're not going to put our foot off the gas. We're going to go attack people, and we're going to do it for four quarters." Meanwhile, Louisiana Tech had 38 cases of COVID last week and had to cancel their game vs Baylor. The Bulldogs were already one of the least experienced teams in the country with only 8 returning starters. Even if all their players get cleared, they've missed two weeks of practice. We like Southern Miss.

**Texas St 35 UL-MONROE 28.** Texas St has received heavy action so far this week from the Wise Guys. They got money in the market last week until QB Brady McBride was ruled out late in the week due to COVID (may come back here). Texas St had a 26-24 first down edge but UTSA had a 499-474 yard edge including 330-125 on the ground in UTSA's thrilling 51-48 upset win. Texas St got a 91-yard punt return TD with 1:16 left but missed the extra point that would have given them the win. Tyler Vitt started at QB for Texas St and was 26 of 39 for 346 yards and 4 TD's (also 2 INT's). On the other side, heavy money came in against ULM in their 37-7 loss vs Army (line went from +16 to +24). Army dominated with 24-9 first down and 465-200 yard edges including 436-37 on the ground. ULM QB Colby Suits was 14 of 19 for 148 yards and a 1-0 ratio in his debut. Texas St has not been a favorite on the road since 2014 but we feel it is deserved here.

**FBS VIP Plays 7-1 So Far This Year!!!**

**Smu 45 NORTH TEXAS 31.** Both teams come in off byes after wins in Week 1. SMU had 26-22 first down and 544-416 yard edges including a 10.2-5.8 yards per pass advantage but had to hold on to beat Texas St 31-24. Meanwhile, the Mean Green did have a 721-569 yard edge vs Houston Baptist including 360-89 on the ground. The 721 yards were a school-record for North Texas. North Texas QB Jason Bean looks like the clear starter as he was 11 of 18 for 217 yards and a 3-1 ratio. We expect a ton of points here and both teams saw a lot of points left on the field (both them and their opponents) in their openers. We like the OVER.

**TULANE 28 Navy 22.** Navy comes in off a much-needed bye after a disastrous Labor Day 55-3 loss to BYU. BYU dominated with 28-7 first down and 580-149 yard edges including 301-119 on the ground. Navy head coach Ken Niumatalolo put most of his emphasis in camp at doing whatever it took to keep his players safe from the coronavirus. "Boy, that game was 1000 percent my fault," Niumatalolo said. "Obviously, we weren't prepared...I erred on the side of trying to keep our guys safe. I'd say it's the worst Navy football game we ever played. You ever see us play like that before? You hope that it doesn't turn out like that, but there was a lot of concern," Niumatalolo said. "The last time we tackled anybody was the bowl game, nine months ago. I made a decision on the safety side of it, and we were weren't prepared." Navy has went full-contact the last couple of weeks and we expect to see a much improved team. On the other side, Tulane rallied from a 24-6 mid-3Q deficit to beat South Alabama 27-24. According to ESPN Gamecast, South Alabama had a 95% chance to win! Tulane QB Keon Howard was 14 of 30 for 191 yards in his first start. Navy is 32-14-1 ATS as a road underdog since 2003. Lean Navy.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE 31 Troy 30.** This is the first of two meetings with Troy hosting Middle Tennessee on November 21st. MT comes in off a bye after a disastrous opening season 42-0 loss to Army. Army dominated with 24-13 first down and 368-184 yard edges including 340-75 on the ground. Army was also +4 in TO's including an interception return TD. Clearly, the Blue Raiders were not prepared to defend the option and offensively QB's Chase Cunningham and Asher O'Hara combined to go 16 of 24 for 109 yards and 2 INT's. They will have a game under their belt advantage here vs a Troy team that has to replace their starting QB who was All-SBC. MT has stark home/away splits the last 6 years going 26-9 SU (59% ATS) at home vs going 14-29 SU (45% ATS) away from home. We think the market overreacted to Middle's blowout loss and think there is value on the home dog here.

**NOTRE DAME 37 South Florida 10.** Last week ND struggled vs Duke in a 27-13 win (-21.5). ND had 24-18 first down and 441-332 yard edges including 178-73 on the ground. QB Ian Book struggled at times going 19 of 31 for 263 yards and a 1-1 ratio. RB Kyren Williams was the star running for 112 yards and 2 TD's while also adding 93 receiving yards. The Blue Devils, who had 246 yards at halftime, had just 82 after halftime. On the other side, the Bulls won their first game under new head coach Jeff Scott 27-6 (-17) over the Citadel. USF had 20-16 first down and 404-284 yard edges including 302-200 on the ground. USF was +3 in TO's and got a fluke punt return TD. QB Jordan McCloud was 11 of 16 for 68 yards and a TD and will struggle vs a very good ND defense. USF actually beat ND outright in their only meeting (2011). It won't be close this time. Lean UNDER.

**OKLAHOMA ST 45 Tulsa 24.** This game was originally scheduled for last week but Tulsa had limited practice time in fall camp due to COVID. These teams met last year with Oklahoma St winning 40-21 but note that Tulsa actually led 21-20 at halftime. Oklahoma St RB Chuba Hubbard did run for 256 yards in that one. Tulsa should have an improved offense with 9 returning starters led by QB Zach Smith but the defense returns only 4 starters and will be taking on one of the best offenses in the country. The Pokes return Hubbard who led the nation with 2,094 rushing yards last year. QB Spencer Sanders is also back along with their top 3 receivers. The defense should be improved thanks to the return of 10 starters. Oklahoma St is on a 13-1 ATS run in their last 14 non-conference games with an average cover of 10.5 ppg but this line is a bit pricey. We lean OVER.

**2★ Houston (plus the points) BAYLOR 31 Houston 30.** First-year head coaches are now 2-8 ATS this season. Baylor not only has a new head coach in Dave Aranda (never been a head coach before) but the Bears are also one of the least experienced teams in the country with only 9 returning starters (only 2 on defense). Meanwhile, Houston has 19 returning starters and is in the Top 5 of returning production. Baylor released their depth chart on Tuesday, four starters weren't listed and the rumor is it is COVID related. Not sure if they'll be back for this one but there was a lot of practice time lost. Center Xavier Newman is out (non-COVID related). Speaking of practice time, Houston had 8 spring practices, Baylor had 0. Teams with 5 or more spring practices than their opponent (both playing first game) are 6-2 ATS this year. We hit an early number but still really like Houston.

They're taking on an Austin Peay team that is already playing their 3rd game of the season. That should count for something except for the fact the Governors were thoroughly embarrassed by Pitt last week. It was so bad that the coaches agreed to play only 10 minute quarters in the second half. That dealt Pitt (-30) backers a bad beat in the 55-0 white-washing. Not sure if it's 55-0 bad, but we want no part of the dog here.

**UTSA 37 Stephen F. Austin 20.** Last week UTSA got a thrilling 51-48 upset win over Texas St in the debut of head coach Jeff Traylor. Frank Harris got the start at QB for UTSA and was 23 of 31 for 169 yards while also adding 51 rushing yards and 3 TD's. UTSA RB Sincere McCormick ran for a school-record 197 yards. They're taking on a Stephen F. Austin team that lost by 10 to lowly UTEP a couple weeks back. We lean with the favorite.

**CLEMSON 54 The Citadel 3.** Last week the preseason favorite Clemson Tigers had 27-15 first down and 561-330 yard edges including 185-37 on the ground but couldn't cover vs Wake Forest. Clemson led 27-0 at halftime and QB Trevor Lawrence was 22 of 28 for 351 yards and a TD and also rushed for 2 more TD's. They will be able to name their score here vs a Citadel team (runs the option) that struggled vs USF last week (lost 27-6 as 17-point underdogs). Note Clemson has won their last 4 games vs FCS opponents by 50.75 ppg!

**Central Arkansas at Arkansas St** has been moved to October 10th. Arkansas St was without 20 players, including 8 starters, at Kansas St last week (they went outright anyways!). ASU said the postponement of UCA game was school unable to assemble a full 2-deep depth chart at a specific position.

**UTEP 27 Abilene Christian 24.** The Miners come in off a off a blowout 59-3 loss at Texas. The Longhorns had 28-14 first down and 689-233 yard edges including 208-43 on the ground. Texas led 45-3 at halftime. They are playing in their third game of the season while Abilene Christian is playing their first game of the season and is lightly experienced with only 8 returning starters and lost their QB to transfer. UTEP gets their second win of the season!

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**CLEVELAND 23 Cincinnati 17.** The Browns continue to be the most disappointing franchise in the NFL since their return in 1999. They dropped to 1-20-1 SU in season openers after an embarrassing 38-6 loss to the Ravens. QB Mayfield has thrown 36 INT's since 2018 (2nd most). Speaking of QB's Cincinnati rookie Joe Burrow was a pedestrian 26 of 36 for 193 yards but a late game-tying 31-yard FG to force OT was badly missed and the Bengals "pushed" in a 16-13 loss to the Chargers. Now Burrow and company are traveling on a short week. We lean UNDER.

### Sunday, September 20th

**L.A. Rams 22 PHILADELPHIA 21.** Two teams that had disparate results in Week 1. The Rams "upset" the Cowboys on SNF as we cashed on these pages. Note that L.A. took heavy money in the market place. Rumors were flying that Billy Walters (most successful sports bettor of all time and now out of prison) was on the Rams and the line closed "Pick-Em" (we gave them out +3). On the other side, the Eagles blew a 17-0 lead to Washington as they allowed "The Football Team" to score 27 unanswered (PHI -3 in TO's). The Eagles offensive line is really banged up (allowed 8 sacks vs WAS) and now face the best defensive lineman in the league in Aaron Donald. Early money is on the Rams again here and that's where our lean is. Still not optimal playing a 10am PT start across country after SNF. We lean UNDER.

**2★ OVER 47.5. TAMPA BAY 31 Carolina 21.** It was a sobering start to the Tom Brady era in Tampa Bay as the Bucs fell to the Saints 34-23. Brady threw 2 INT's including a back-breaking "Pick-6" in the second half. He did become the oldest player to score a TD in the NFL since at least 1950. On the other side, even though the Panthers lost 34-30 at failed to cover vs the Raiders, the debut of head coach Matt Rhule and QB Teddy Bridgewater should give Panthers fans some hope that they can be competitive this year. Still, they face a motivated Brady here. We like the OVER here as the Panthers run a lot of tempo, but their defense will be among the worst in the NFL this year.

**PITTSBURGH 24 Denver 17.** Both teams coming off Monday night games. Pittsburgh was able to beat the Giants 26-16 as the defense shut down Giants RB Saquon Barkley (6 rushing yards). Big Ben was solid at 21 of 32 for 229 yards and a 3-0 ratio. Meanwhile, Denver barely cashed on these pages for us in their 16-14 loss to Tennessee thanks to 3 missed FG's. Head coach Vic Fangio continues to mis-manage late game situations as the Broncos finished the game with 2 timeouts. Hey Vic, timeouts aren't cell phone minute plans. They don't carry over! Historically Big Ben has performed better at home than on the road but we don't want to lay more than a TD here. Pass.

**DALLAS 29 Atlanta 23.** Last week we cashed fading the Cowboys in their 20-17 loss to the Rams. Still, Dallas was a controversial OPI call away from forcing OT. New head coach Mike McCarthy also had a questionable decision going for it in the red zone in the 4Q. On the other side, the Falcons were out-classed by the Seahawks. Matt Ryan's stats looked good (450 passing yards) but only because he was throwing down multiple scores for most of the game. We like the Cowboys to bounce back here but note they lost key LB Leighton Vander Esch to a broken collarbone.

**San Francisco 24 N.Y. JETS 17.** Fading San Francisco was another winner for us on these pages last week in their upset loss to Arizona. There was nothing fluky about it as the Cards had the first down (29-18) and yardage edge. The 49ers have struggled vs mobile QB's the last couple of years. Newsflash Jets QB Sam Darnold isn't mobile. New York looked bad last week as Buffalo had 29-14 first down and 404-254 yard edges. To make matters worse, RB Le'Veon Bell is now on IR with a hamstring injury. We could only look at the 49ers here but aren't keen on laying a full TD on the road.

**Buffalo 24 MIAMI 17.** The Bills were dominating the Jets last week but a couple of fumbles by QB Allen and a couple missed FG's kept them in the game. Still Buffalo won more convincingly than the 27-17 final with 31-15 first down and 404-254 yard edges. Allen did have the first 300-yard passing game of his career. Meanwhile, the Dolphins were out-rushed 217-87 vs the Patriots in a 10-point loss while QB Ryan Fitzpatrick threw 3 INT's. We're not crazy laying nearly a TD on the road with the Bills but they should control the line of scrimmage here.

**2★ Minnesota 24 INDIANAPOLIS 23.** Both teams had playoff aspirations coming into the season and both suffered embarrassing losses in Week 1. The Vikings were controlled much worse than the final vs the Packers. The overhaul of their defense was exposed by QB Aaron Rodgers and Company to the tune of 522 yards. Meanwhile, the Colts somehow lost to the "tanking" Jacksonville Jaguars 27-20. It was a misleading final as the Colts had 27-17 first down and 445-241 yard edges. New QB Philip Rivers threw for 357 yards but also 2 costly INT's and the Colts lost RB Marlon Mack (Achilles). We trust Minnesota HC Mike Zimmer to bounce back and still think the Vikings are the better team. Catching a full FG here, we think they are the play.

**GREEN BAY 27 Detroit 23.** Two teams with disparate NFC North results last week. The Packers controlled the Vikings worse than the final as they piled up 522 yards vs Minnesota's defense. QB Aaron Rodgers was razor sharp going 32 of 44 for 364 yards and a 4-0 ratio. That's now 7 straight division wins for them. Meanwhile, it's good to see that even in the upside down year of 2020, we can still count on the Detroit Lions to do...well Detroit Lions' type of things like blowing a 23-6 4Q lead vs Chicago last week. Rookie RB D'Andre Swift also dropped a sure-fire TD in the final minute. Last year with backup QB's the Lions only lost by a combined 4 points to the Packers. We lean with the dog.

**CHICAGO 21 N.Y. Giants 17.** We're wondering what this line would have been had the Bears not scored 3 TD's in the 4Q to pull off the shocker vs the Lions last week. Still, you have to give credit to QB Mitch Trubisky for being able to pull it off. The Giants meanwhile lost by 10 to the Steelers on MNF in head coach Joe Judge's debut. One of the more shocking stats of Week 1 was RB Saquon Barkley only managing 6 rushing yards on 15 carries. The G-Men do have a rebuilt offensive line. Can't lay 5.5 with the home team here. We expect Trubisky of the first 3Q's, not the 4Q to show here.

**TENNESSEE 27 Jacksonville 17.** Last week Jacksonville probably wiped out nearly half of all Survivor contestants as they pulled the shocker beating Indianapolis outright as TD underdogs. The final was misleading considering the Colts had 27-17 first down and 445-241 yard edges. Still it was noteworthy that QB Minshew was 19 of 20 with 3 TD passes and now is incredibly 7-6 SU as a starter. On the other side, we cashed fading the Titans last week but we were more lucky than good considering the Titans missed 3 FG's. We're not anxious to lay near doubles here but note Tennessee has won 6 straight home games vs JAX by an average of 11 ppg.

**ARIZONA 26 Washington 20.** Both teams pulled outright upset wins in Week 1 as near-TD underdogs. We were more surprised with Washington's result especially considering they trailed 17-0 early. Still, their defensive line abused a banged up Philly offensive line to the tune of 8 sacks and "The Football Team" was also +3 in TO's. On the other side, the Cardinals beat the 49ers outright. It was deserved considering Arizona had a 29-18 first down edge. Newly acquired WR DeAndre Hopkins had a career-high 14 receptions and QB Kyler Murray ran for 91 yards! Arizona is not accustomed to laying this kind of number as they are 0-3 SU as chalk since 2017. We're passing.

**Baltimore 30 HOUSTON 22.** Wow, what a schedule to start the season for Houston playing the top two teams in the NFL. The Texans were once again out-classed by the Chiefs last week losing 34-20 and really only managed to get the offense going in the 4Q. Last year's matchup between these two was a wipe-out with Baltimore winning 41-7 (491-232 yard edge). Meanwhile, The Ravens have the best roster in the NFL and it showed vs the Browns in Week 1 with a 38-6 dismantling. Again, we're not thrilled laying 7 on the road here vs DeShaun Watson but also can't go against the Ravens. Pass.

**Kansas City 28 L.A. CHARGERS 20.** The Chiefs have now remarkably won and covered 10 straight games dating back to last season after their 34-20 win over Houston on Thursday. Clearly, the market has not caught up to the greatness of Patrick Mahomes. However, the Chiefs defense is also improved and head coach Andy Reid is arguably the 2nd best coach in the league. Also notable is the addition of rookie RB Edwards-Helaire (25 carries for 138 yards in his debut). That's going to be tough to beat especially for a Chargers team that barely got by a rookie QB in Week 1. We won't be laying this number on the road but advantage teaser players should consider teasing the Chiefs down to -2.5 (through key numbers of 7 and 3).

**2★ New England (plus the points) SEATTLE 23 New England 22.** Cam Newton did just fine in his debut for the Patriots last week as he was 15 of 19 throwing while adding 75 rushing yards and 2 TD's. It was the 17th time New England has topped 200 yards rushing under Belichick and they've won all 17. Meanwhile, Russell Wilson put on a show last week vs the Falcons going 31 of 35 for 322 yards and 4 TD's. Seattle may have the best home field advantage in the NFL but that is severely negated with no "12th Man". It's not often that we get to play New England as an underdog (were favored in every game last year) and we like it even more that they're getting more than a FG here.

### Monday, September 21st

**New Orleans 27 LAS VEGAS 23.** The first ever game in Las Vegas for the Raiders and what a missed opportunity because of the global pandemic. This would have been one of the best atmospheres in sports in 2020 but remember no fans for this one. Las Vegas did appropriately get a win and a 1-point cover at Carolina last week. The offense was led by RB Jacobs (3 TD's) but the defense did struggle. Note that defense did go up against Joe Brady (Carolina OC) who runs a very similar system to New Orleans. Meanwhile, the Saints benefited from a couple of Tom Brady INT's in their 34-23 win. QB Brees looked his age going 18 of 30 for 160 yards. We lean with the home dog. It would've been our top play of the week with fans.
