Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all hardwoods (except oak and cherry); and aspen (designated) containing 1 or more 100-inch pulpsticks. Retain all oak, cherry and conifers except for marked spruce. Every 5th row of this plantation has all trees painted with vertical orange marks providing minimum 10-ft wide logging access lanes. Utilize hardwood sawlogs to a 10-inch minimum DIB top and pulpwood to a 4-inch minimum DOB top.

GENERAL SALE OPERATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

No logging during April, May or June. New roads must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Existing roads and trails shall be kept free of debris and restored to original condition prior to sale close-out. Excessive rutting or residual stand damage will result in sale suspension or closure. Wisconsin's Best Management Practices for Water Quality shall be implemented in all phases of the sale. Private lands must be crossed to access this sale.

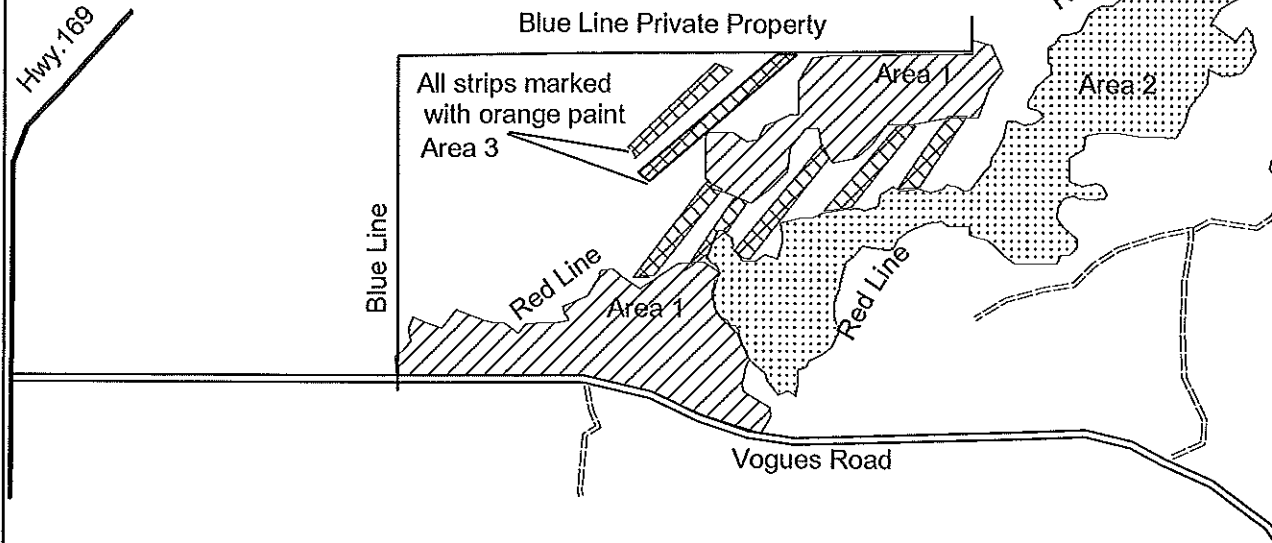

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint along with all aspen, balsam fir, and spruce. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Piece along road can be harvested at anytime except April 1st thru July 1st.

Harvest Specifications Area 2 (67 acres)

Harvest all balsam fir, spruce, aspen, and trees > 10 inches dbh. Leave all cedar, hemlock, and pine. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Can only be harvested from December 1st thru March.

Harvest Specifications Area 3 (9 acres)

Harvest everything 2 inches dbh and up, except for cedar, hemlock, and pine. The strips are approximately 66 feet wide and approximately 132 feet apart. Utilize pulpwood to a 4 inch top diameter, sawlogs to a minimum 10 inch top diameter. Follow the BMP's and prevent/minimize rutting along with damage to residual trees. Can only be harvested from December 1st thru March.

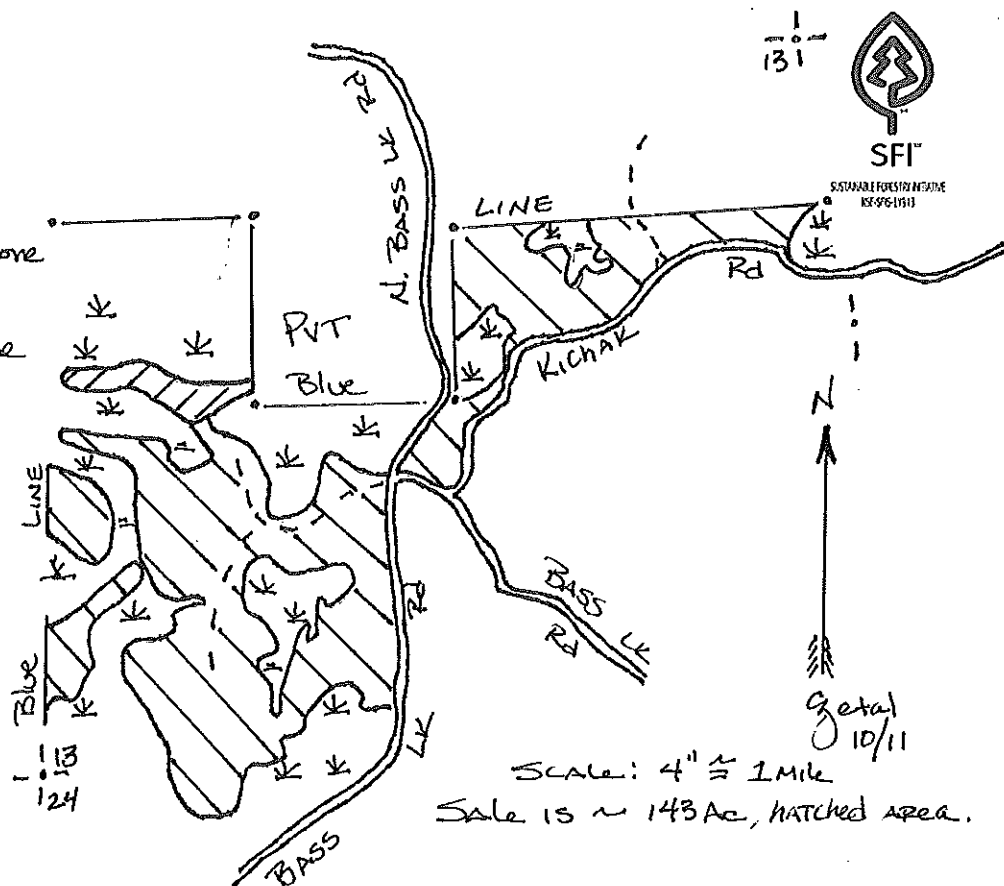


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Regeneration Harvest Zone
